VERSUS

REPORT OF HEARING

A Petition signed by 9 property owners having been presented to the Supervisors of Decatur Township, under the Act of May 1, 1933, Article 11, Section 1101, as amended, to take over as a Township Road a certain street or road beginning west of Chester Hill Borough and extending to Chester Hill Borough and known as Forest Street and it appearing to the Supervisors as said road should be connected with Route 17006 for the public convenience, all of the proposed roads being hereinafter described, the time and place for hearing was duly set as 10:00 p.m., at the Friends Town Schoolhouse on the 9th day of July 1956.

Ten days written notice of the time and place of hearing having been given to all property owners affected by the proposal to ordain Forest Street as Township Road and to layout and ordain a Township Road connecting Forest Street with Route 17016, such hearing was duly held at 10:00 p.m., July 9, 1956, at the Friends Town Schoolhouse.

The center line of the proposed road being described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Legislative Route 17006, with center line being sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) feet South 52 degrees 2 minutes East from the original tract line of the John Gearhart Estate; thence North 33 degrees 30 minutes East across the lands of Jacob Mandel of a distance of Fifty (50) feet to the lands of the Philipsburg Coal and Land Company; thence 33 degrees 30 minutes East of the lands of the Philipsburg Coal and Land Company for a distance of Three Hundred twenty-seven (327) feet to Smith Street; thence across Smith Street to the lands of John W. Johnson; thence North 42 degrees 00 minutes East across the lands of John W. Johnson for a distance of Two Hundred Fifty-one and five tenths (251.5) feet to Pine Street and Township Road No. 673 thence crossing said Pine Street on Township Road No. 673 to the lands of Mary Wolf; thence North 42 degrees 00 minutes East across lands of Mary Wolf for a distance of Five Hundred twenty-two (522) feet to Forest Street; thence in an Easterly direction along Forest Street and the lands of Mary Wolf; John Wanchisn; Michael Czar; Ella Prusmuk; John H. Croft; John Blasko; John Comitz and George Johnson to the Borough line of Chester Hill Borough. The right-of-way for said Township Road being Thirty-three (33) feet in width and sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) feet on each side of the lines herein above described.

At the time and place of said hearing, there appeared George W. Johnson and John Comitz, both being owners of property abutting the affect of the road, and both testifying that the proposed road was necessary for the public convenience and specifically that such proposed road was necessary to give them access to their properties in the winter.

Being laid out and ordained as a Township Road.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO TAKE OVER, LAYOUT AND ORDAIN AS
TOWNSHIP ROAD A CERTAIN PORTION OF ROAD NEAR
CHESTER HILL BOROUGH IN DECATUR TOWNSHIP,
CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, a petition was presented to the Supervisors of Decatur Township, under the Act of May 1, 1933, Article XI, Section 1101, to take over, layout and ordain the hereinafter described public road as a township road, and notice was duly given and hearing held thereon as set forth in Report of Hearing being duly filed August 8, 1956, in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania to No. / May Sessions, 1956, setting forth the finding by the Decatur Township Supervisors that the road therein and hereinafter described should be ordained as a township road and that the same was necessary for public convenience,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY
THE SUPERVISORS OF DECATUR TOWNSHIP AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

THAT, by virtue of the authority of the Act of May 1, 1933, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, all that section of road in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania,

BEGINNING at a point on the Northern side of Legislative Route 17426, with center line being sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) feet South 52 degrees 2 minutes East from the original tract line of the John Gearhart Estate; thence North 33 degrees 30 minutes East across the lands of Jacob Munder of a distance of Fifty (50) feet to the lands of the Philipsburg Coal and Land Company; thence 33 degrees 30 minutes East of the lands of the Philipsburg Coal and Land Company for a distance of Three hundred twenty-seven (327) feet to Smith Street; thence across Smith Street to the lands of John W. Johnson; thence North 42 degrees 00 minutes East across the lands of John W. Johnson for a distance of Two Hundred Fifty-one and five tenths (251.5) feet to Pine Street and Township Road No. 673 thence crossing said Pine Street on Township Road No. 673 to the lands of Mary Wolf; thence North 42 degrees 00 minutes East across lands of Mary Wolf for a distance of Five Hundred twenty-two (522) feet to Forest Street; thence in an Easterly direction along Forest Street and the lands of Mary Wolf; John Vanchian; Michael Czar; Ella Prusnak; John H. Croft; John Blasko; John Comitz and George Johnson to the Borough line of Chester Hill Borough. The right-of-way for said Township Road being Thirty-three (33) feet in width and sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) ft. on each side of the lines herein above described, is

taken over, laid out and ordained as township road to be taken over, laid out, kept and maintained as a township road by the Supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2.

Notice of the adoption of this ordinance shall be

given within ten (10) days thereafter by handbills posted in conspicuous places along the line of the said road, such handbills to state the fact of the passage of this ordinance and the date thereof.

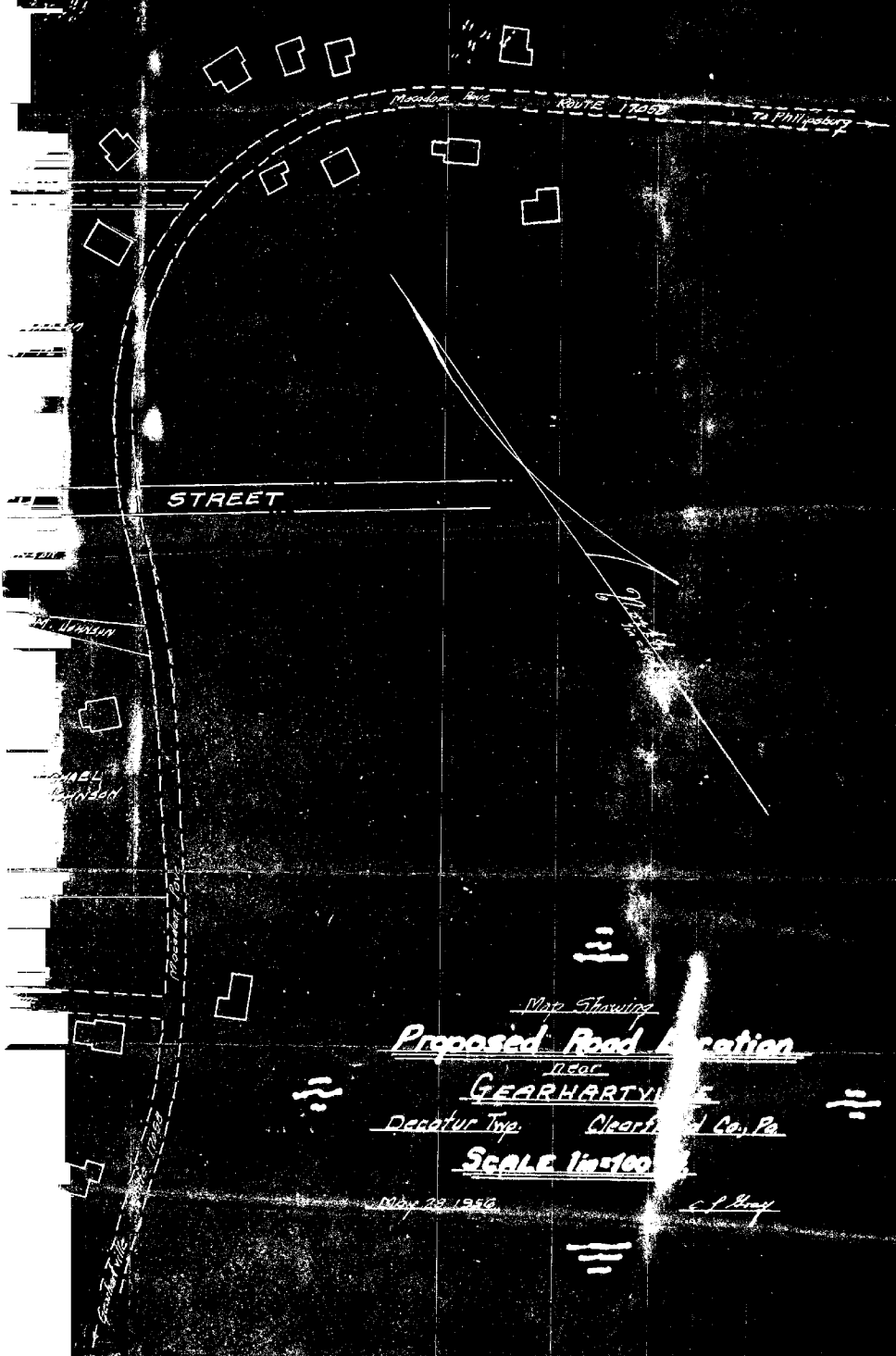
