ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, all of whom are over twenty-one years of age, and are citizens and residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and of the United States, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a Corporation, under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of May 5, 1933, as follows:

1. The name of the proposed Corporation is GREENWOOD GRANGE NO. 706, INCORPORATED, and which name has been registered with the Department of State, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, within six months of the date of this application.

2. The location of the said Corporation is R. D. 2, Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and its Post Office address is R. D. 2, Mahaffey, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

3. The purposes of the said Corporation are to promote and encourage interest in agriculture and associated activities for the purpose of improving methods of production and to foster and encourage social relations and mutual assistance among the members, and to affiliate with the National Grange Order of Patrons of Husbandry together with all the rights and privileges incidental thereto. The said Corporation does not contemplate any pecuniary gain or profit incidental or otherwise to its members.

4. The term for which the Corporation is to exist is perpetual.

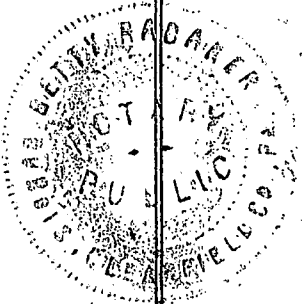

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
DECREE OF INCORPORATION

AND NOW, this 11th day of June, 1956, an application for a charter, and the Articles of Incorporation of GREENWOOD GRANGE NO. 706, INCORPORATED, under the "nonprofit Corporation Law" approved May 5, 1933, as amended, having been presented for approval to me, a law judge of the said county, accompanied by proof of the publication of the notice of such application and a certificate from the Department of State showing the registration of the proposed corporated name as required by law, I do hereby certify that I have perused and examined the said instruments and that I find the same to be in the proper form and within the provisions and requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, known as "The Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved May 5, 1933, as amended; and that the purposes of the proposed corporation appear to be lawful and not injurious to the community. It is therefore ordered and decreed that the Articles of Incorporation of GREENWOOD GRANGE No. 706, INCORPORATED, be and the same are hereby approved and that upon the recording of the said Articles and this order, the subscribers thereto and their associates and successors, shall be a body politic and corporate in deed and in law by the name of GREENWOOD GRANGE NO. 706, INCORPORATED, which shall exist perpetually and shall be invested with, and have and enjoy all the powers, privileges, and franchises incident to a nonprofit

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corporation and be subject to all the duties, requirements, and restrictions specified and enjoined in and by the Nonprofit Corporation Law," and all other applicable laws of this Commonwealth.

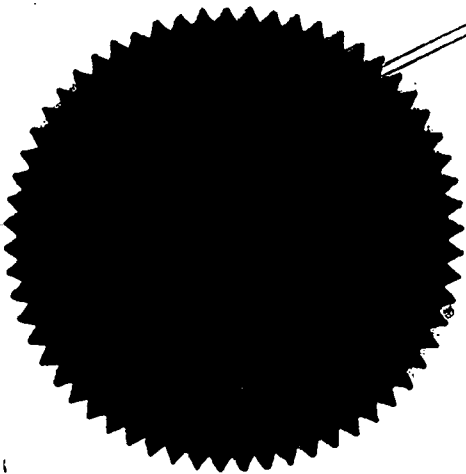
