BE IT KNOWN, That the undersigned, all residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and citizens of the United States, and all of whom are of full age, having associated themselves together for the purpose of organizing the DUBOIS AREA JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, and being desirous of becoming incorporated in accordance with the provisions of the Nonprofit Corporation Law, approved May 5, 1933, as amended, do hereby declare, set forth and certify as follows:

1. That the name of the corporation is the DUBOIS AREA JUNIOR CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, and that the location and post office of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is No. 317 Spring Avenue, in the City of DuBois, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. That the purpose or purposes of the corporation are as follows:

To promote and foster civic service through the organized effort of the young men of the area and to promote the welfare of the area and its citizens through active constructive projects. It shall be the further purpose of this organization to provide training in leadership and civic consciousness for its constituent membership and to better their usefulness as citizens, the same being a corporation which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incident or otherwise, to its members.

3. That the term of its existence is perpetual.
