Pursuant to Article VII, Section 702, Clause XLI of the Act of 1933 P. L. 103 as amended June 1, 1956, the Board of Supervisors of Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, publish prior to passage, the following Ordinance which will be voted upon by said Supervisors at a meeting to be held, November 5, 1956 at 7:30 o'clock p. m. at the residence of Robert Potter, Karthaus, Pennsylvania:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE providing for the opening, ordaining and laying out of a Township Road, entirely within the Township of Karthaus, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania and providing a date when said Ordinance shall become effective.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Karthaus, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

Section 1. That by virtue of the Authority of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101 et seq., as amended June 1, 1956, the following described land is hereby opened, ordained and laid out as a Township Road entirely within the Township of Karthaus, Clearfield County Pennsylvania:

The center line of said Township Road shall begin at a point on the northern right-of-way line of State Highway L. R. 17068 at Station 0 plus 30, thence north 7 degrees 30 minutes west 412 feet on Hurxthal Street to a point in the center of Water Street at Station 4 plus 42; thence south 82 degrees 40 minutes west 375 feet on Water Street to the eastern right-of-way line of Potter Street, Township Road No. 746, at Station 8 plus 17. The said Township Road shall be 50 feet in width and 25 feet of said width shall extend



REPORT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF KARTHAUS

TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The board of Supervisors of Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, respectfully reports as follows:

1. That the undersigned were duly elected and qualified as Supervisors of the Township of Karthaus, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. That the Supervisors as aforesaid, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of 1933, P.L. 511, Sec. 1102 as amended, 53 P.S. 19093 - 1102, gave by personal service, more than ten days prior to the below mentioned meeting, notice of the said meeting and the purpose thereof to Mary A. Miller, John Moore, Clair E. Reiter, Ethel Potter, Graydon Teats, Lillian Reiter, Parks Moore and Philip Rees, all of Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, they being the only known persons in interest, of the proposed passage of an ordinance laying out and opening the below described road.
3. That attached to and made a part of this report are the following:
  - (a) A copy of the aforesaid notice, marked as exhibit "A"
  - (b) Acceptance by copy of the aforesaid notice on or before the 26th day of October, 1956, signed by the known persons in interest as above set forth, said instrument being marked as exhibit "B".
4. Pursuant to the several Acts of Assembly the said Supervisors, on October 31, 1956, published in the Clearfield Progress, a newspaper circulating generally in the Township of Karthaus, a copy of a proposed ordinance laying out and opening the below described road; a copy of said advertisement and proof

of publication are hereunto attached and marked as exhibit "C".

5. That pursuant to the notices as aforesaid, a meeting of the Karthaus Township Supervisors was held at the residence of Robert Potter, Karthaus, Pennsylvania, on the 5th day of November, 1956, at 7:30 o'clock p.m., and that at said meeting there were present the undersigned members of the board of Supervisors of Karthaus Township, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Township of Karthaus and no other person.

6. That at the said meeting no objection was made to the proposed laying out and opening of the said road and the Ordinance effecting the same was passed unanimously at said meeting.

7. That the said Ordinance fully describes the road in question and an attested copy of the said ordinance is hereunto attached, made a part hereof and marked exhibit "D".

8. That also attached to this report, made a part hereof and marked exhibit "E" is a draft and survey of the road showing the location and width thereof.

9. That in the opinion of the undersigned Supervisors of Karthaus Township the laying out and opening of the said road is necessary to the public convenience.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned board of Supervisors files this report in the office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

NOTICE OF HEARING BY KARTHAUS TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS

Notice is hereby given that the Supervisors of Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, will hold a hearing on the Fifth day of November, 1956 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. at the residence of Robert Potter, Karthaus, Pennsylvania, to determine the advisability and necessity of opening, ordaining and laying out as a Township Road, the following proposed Township Road in the village of Karthaus, Karthaus Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania:

The center line of said road shall begin at a point on the northern right-of-way line of State Highway L.R. 17068 at Station 0-30, thence north 7 degrees 30 minutes west 412 feet on Hurxthal Street to a point in the center of Water Street at Station 4 $\frac{1}{4}$  42; thence south 82 degrees 40 minutes west 375 feet on Water Street to the eastern right-of-way line of Potter Street, Township Road # 746, at Station 8 $\frac{1}{4}$  17. The proposed Township Road shall be 50 feet in width and 25 feet of said width shall extend on each side of the line herein above described.

At the above time and place all parties interested may meet and be heard. Witnesses may be summoned and examined by the supervisors and by the parties interested at such meeting or any adjournment thereof.

Section 1.
