AN ORDINANCE

Dedicating to and accepting by the Township of Morris, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, certain streets in the Village of Troy, Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, known as Lincoln, Howard and Duncan Streets.

Section 1. BE IT ENACTED by the Supervisors of Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same; that the Township of Morris does hereby accept and dedicate Lincoln, Howard, and Duncan Streets as designated on the plan attached to the original Petition for dedication by the adjoining owners of said land in the Township of Morris, and said Lincoln, Howard and Duncan Streets in the said Troy Village are hereby adopted, accepted, dedicated and ordained as streets in said Township in the locations and positions and having the same dimensions as shown on the map or plan hereinbefore mentioned.

And, it is hereby further enacted and ordained that the said streets above referred to in Section One (1) hereof, be dedicated and accepted as streets in the said Village of Troy, Morris Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

Adopted and enacted this 3rd day of November, in the year one thousand nine hundred and fifty-six (1956).
