CLEARFIELD COUNTY, SS.:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the 27 day of

June

A. D. 1865 before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Gerard in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from

on account of a portion of the public Road leading from the Residence of Mr. Murry on the Clearfield and Kaithaus road to a point where the present Road intersects said Road has become out of repair is burdensome to keep up and from its present location does great damage to the property through which it passes and to create that part of said Road from where it passes the lands of Francis Hugar and Joseph Bennett to the intersection of the Clearfield Road on the Kaithaus and Clearfield Road a new Road opened from the corner of Hugar and Bennett lands to the Clearfield and Kaithaus Road where a Private Road now is.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

A. B. Shaw, J. E. O'Leary and J. M. Shaw

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances; and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
