ORDINANCE  
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING  
AND OPENING A PUBLIC ROAD  
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF GOSHEN,  
COUNTY OF CLEARFIELD AND  
STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA

BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. A Township Road is hereby established and opened and made a part of the general road system of the Township of Goshen.

Beginning at the point of intersection of Birch Street in the Village of Croft, Goshen Township, with Legislative Route No. 879, leading from Shawville to LeContes Mills, Pa., thence extending in a general northeasterly direction for a distance of about 810 feet to a point at or near the Christian Alliance Church in said Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; said proposed road to have a width of 33 feet and an overall length of approximately 810 feet, a plan or draft of said public road, adopted as a part of this ordinance can be examined in the office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County where a copy of this ordinance will be filed, on the 12th day of January, 1959.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective on the 15th day of January, 1959.



We, the undersigned duly elected and qualified Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, upon petition of the property owners affected, requesting the Supervisors of Goshen Township to take over a private road or street known as Birch Street, in the Village of Croft, Goshen Township, as part of the General Road System of said Township; said proposed road as laid out by the Supervisors of the Township of Goshen being hereafter specifically described, and in conformity with the provisions of the Act of Assembly of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. XI, Sec. 1102, as amended by Act of June 1, 1955, P.L. 2021 (P.S. 53 Sec. 66101 and 66102), in such case made and provided do hereby, make report as follows:-

(1) That the undersigned Board of Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen, pursuant to the provisions of the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, Art. II Sec. 1102 as amended by Act of June 1, 1955, P.L. 2021, Sec. 1102 (a) (53 P.S. 66102-(a)), gave ten days written notice to the property owners affected; namely, the Harbison-Walker Refractories, Boyd E. Rougeaux, Charles M. Martell, and George A. Liddick, that a meeting would be held at the law offices of A. B. Shaw, Esq., situate at 203 Market Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, on Saturday, December 27, 1958, at 10:00 A.M., for the purpose of determining the necessity and advisability of taking over said proposed road or street as part of the General Road System of the Township of Goshen, a copy of said notice being hereto attached and made a part of this report, marked Exhibit "A."

Township Road District, on Saturday, December 31, 1958, at 10:00 A.M., when the following appearances were noted: A. B. Shaw, Esq. Solicitor for Goshen Township Road District; George J. Read, and Jack C. Hill, Supervisors of Goshen Township; also, Charles M. Martell, George A. Liddick, Petitioners; and other parties and interests; all of whom are sworn and examined by Counsel and your Board. There being no apparent objection to said proposed road, the meeting was adjourned for the procurement of a release of damages from the abutting property owners affected and further action by your board.

(3) That said proposed road lies wholly within the Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; and except for certain corrections or deviations acceptable to the property owners and all parties in interest, extends over a private road or street known as Birch Street in the Village of Croft, which said proposed road is specifically prescribed as follows:-

Beginning at the point of intersection of Birch Street in the Village of Croft, Goshen Township, with Legislative Route No. 879, leading from Shawville to LeContes Mills, Pa., thence extending in a general northeasterly direction for a distance of about 810 feet to a point at or near the Christian Alliance Church in said Township of Goshen, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania; said proposed road to have a width of 33 feet and an overall length of approximately 810 feet.

(4) That your undersigned Board of Supervisors after the aforementioned hearing and further investigation made of this matter, and your Board being of the opinion of said proposed road is necessary for the accommodation and convenience of the travelling public, by virtue of powers vested in them, under the aforementioned Acts of Assembly, by resolution of your undersigned Board of Supervisors, duly adopted at a meeting of said Board held on the 9th day of January, 1959, passed an Ordinance for the laying out, opening, and taking over of the aforementioned private road or street, as part of the General Road System of the Township of Goshen; a copy of said Ordinance being hereto attached and made a part of this report, marked Exhibit "B." Also, attached and made a part hereof, is a copy

and proof of publication of said Ordinance as advertised in the Clearfield Progress on January 8, 1959, a paper of general circulation in Clearfield County, preliminary to the passage or adoption of said Ordinance, as required by law, hereto attached, marked Exhibit "C."

(5) Attached hereto and made a part hereof, marked Exhibit "D," is a draft or survey of said proposed road that has been duly adopted and accepted by Resolution and Ordinance by your undersigned Board of Supervisors of Goshen Township, as part of the General Road System of said Township, showing the location of said proposed road, its overall length and fixed termini, and the property owners affected by the laying out and opening thereof.

(6) That attached hereto, and made a part of this report, is the petition of the property owners, or parties in interest, presented to your undersigned Supervisors of the Township of Goshen, requesting the aforementioned proposed road; together with a formal release of all damages by the abutting property owners resulting from the construction and laying out of said public road.

WHEREFORE your undersigned Board of Supervisors of the Road District of the Township of Goshen hereby file report of their official action in these proceedings with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and unless exceptions are filed thereto within thirty (30) days from the date of the filing thereof, said proposed road, as herein described, shall become a part of the General Road System of the Township of Goshen.
