PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The petition of Jos. W. Young, Bryan Peoples and Harry Baney respectfully represents:

1. That they are duly elected members of the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

2. On the plan of lots in Hillsdale, Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, there was dedicated street known as Spring Street, and more particularly portions thereof described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the south right-of-way line of Township Road #593 designated as Hill Street on the map of Hillsdale and the attached map; thence South 21° degrees 04' minutes 30" seconds West, 653 feet to the north right-of-way line of Legislative Route No. 17120 designated as Clark Street on the map of Hillsdale and the attached map. Said Roadway to have a right-of-way width of 40 feet.

3. For over twenty-one (21) years the above described street has from time to time been used as a public thoroughfare and as a means of access to and from properties abutting the same.

4. The plan of Hillsdale operates as a dedication of these streets for public use.

5. It would be to the advantage of the property owners abutting the same and to Lawrence Township to accept said portion of Spring Street as hereinbefore described as a part of the public road system of Lawrence Township.

6. Your petitioners have the authority under the Second Class Township Code to accept by resolution said street.

7. Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a certified copy of the Resolution passed by the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township, accepting said Spring Street and also a plan of said street.

NOW THEREFORE, your petitioners pray your Honorable Court to approve the acceptance of said street hereinbefore described and issue an Order authorizing the same to be added to the road system of Lawrence Township.


ORDER OF COURT

NOW TO WIT this ~~4th~~ day of April, 1959, upon consideration of the foregoing petition, it is hereby ordered and decreed that the following described portion of a street known as Spring Street shall be and is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED to be a part of the Lawrence Township Road System.

Said portion of Spring Street is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the south right-of-way line of Township Road #593 designated as Hill Street on the map of Hillsdale and the attached map; thence South 21° degrees 04' minutes 30" seconds West, 653 feet to the north right-of-way line of Legislative Route No. 17120 designated as Clark Street on the map of Hillsdale and the attached map. Said Roadway to have a right-of-way width of 40 feet.

R E S O L U T I O N

ADOPTING AND ACCEPTING AS PART OF THE ROAD SYSTEM OF

A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET SITUATED IN
LAWRENCE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, a portion of a certain street situated in Lawrence Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania known as Spring Street has been used by the public for over a period of twenty-one (21) years, and

WHEREAS, said street had previously been dedicated for public use, and

WHEREAS, there is nothing among the existing records of the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township which would indicate that said portion of said street has been accepted by the proper Municipal Authority, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best advantage of the surrounding property owners and Lawrence Township that said portion of Spring Street be accepted and adopted as part of the Lawrence Township road system, and

WHEREAS, the authority to adopt dedicated streets is vested in the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township by the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE following described street be and is hereby adopted as part of the road system of Lawrence Township:




