CHARTER IS HEREBY GIVEN
that the Supervisors of Decatur
Township did at their regular meet-
ing held September 12, 1960, enact
an Ordinance taking over, laying
out and ordaining as a township
all those certain portions of
roads bounded and describes as
follows: **THIRTY-THREE** OF:

THE FIRST THREE AT A POINT

BEGINNING at a point two hundred and fifty (250) feet south of the intersection of Township Line State Route 17056 on Township Route 803 and extending in a westerly direction a distance of six hundred and sixty-three (663) feet to a point three hundred (300) feet south of State Route 17056 on

State Route 1736. THEREOF.
THE SECOND. BEGINNING at a point on THE
SHIP ROUTE 657 and extending
an easterly direction for a
distance of nine hundred and

ORDINANCE NO. 11

AN ORDINANCE TO TAKE OVER, LAY OUT AND ORDAIN AS TOWNSHIP ROADS THREE CERTAIN ROADS IN DECATUR TOWNSHIP, CLEARFIELD COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, THE FIRST THEREOF TO CONNECT STATE HIGHWAY 17056 AND STATE HIGHWAY 17136; THE SECOND THEREOF TO EXTEND DECATUR TOWNSHIP ROUTE 657; AND THE THIRD THEREOF TO BEGIN AT A POINT ON STATE HIGHWAY 17058 AND EXTEND TO THE INTERSECTION OF PENNSYLVANIA ROUTE 322.

WHEREAS, at the request of certain citizens of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, for the laying out, ordaining and taking over as a public or township road certain sections of roadway in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, hereinafter described, and after notice duly given and hearing held thereon under the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, and it being determined that the said roads are necessary for public convenience, said Report of Hearing to be filed in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, with this Ordinance, it having been found by the Supervisors of Decatur Township that the roads hereinafter described should be ordained as township roads and that the same is necessary for public convenience,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE SUPERVISORS OF DECATUR TOWNSHIP AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

THAT, by virtue of the authority of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, all that section of road in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point two hundred and fifty (250) feet south of State Route 17056 on Township Route 803 and extending in a westerly direction a distance of six hundred and sixty-three (663) feet to a point three hundred (300) feet south of State Route 17056 on State Route 17136, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof,

is taken over, laid out and ordained as a township road to be taken over, laid out, kept and maintained as a township road by the Supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 2.

THAT, by virtue of the authority of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, all that section of road in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on Township Route 657 and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of nine hundred and ninety (990) feet, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof, is taken over, laid out and ordained as a township road to be taken over, laid out, kept and maintained as a township road by the Supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3.

THAT, by virtue of the authority of the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, all that section of road in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on State Route 17058 and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of four hundred and thirty (430) feet, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof, is taken over, laid out and ordained as a township road to be taken over, laid out, kept and maintained as a township road by the Supervisors of Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 4.

Notice of the adoption of this Ordinance to be published once by the Secretary of the Decatur Township Supervisors in one

newspaper of general circulation in the Township and to be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township and become effective five (5) days after such adoption.





REPORT OF HEARING

The property owners of Decatur Township adjoining three sections of the road proposed to be ordained as a township road having duly executed and delivered to the Township Supervisors a release and surrender of any and all claims arising from the taking over and ordaining of the hereinafter described roads as township roads, and having by the same instrument accepted notice of the hearing to be held, hearing was held September 12, 1960, at 7:00 p.m. in the Decatur Township buildings at Osceola Mills, Pennsylvania, as provided by the Act of May 1, 1933, P. L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, and no persons having appeared as witnesses and the hereinbefore recited releases and surrenders and notice of hearing having been presented to the Board of Supervisors and each of said instruments reciting that the signers thereof agree that the road is necessary for the public convenience, said instruments of release and surrender, acceptance of notice of hearing, and agreement that said road is necessary for public convenience being attached hereto, made a part hereof and incorporated herein by reference, it appearing to the Supervisors of Decatur Township that the sections of road hereinafter described are necessary for the public convenience and that such proposed roads are necessary to give the property owners access to their properties, it is duly resolved that an Ordinance be passed and the Secretary authorized to advertise the same, adopting as a township road those three portions of road in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, described as follows:

THE FIRST THEREOF: BEGINNING at a point two hundred and fifty (250) feet south of State Route 17056 on Township Route 803 and extending in a westerly direction a distance of six hundred and sixty-three (663) feet to a point three hundred (300) feet south of State Route 17056 on State Route 17136, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.

THE SECOND THEREOF: BEGINNING at a point on Township Route 657 and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of nine hundred and ninety (990) feet, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.

THE THIRD THEREOF: BEGINNING at a point on State Route 17058 and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of four hundred and thirty (430) feet, as shown on a sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.






