



C O M P L A I N T

(1). The name of the Plaintiff is the Maple Avenue Hospital, a nonprofit organization, with principal office and place of business in the City of DuBois, Clearfield County, Penna.

(2). The name of the Defendant is Walter Kesslar who resides at 318 Deemer Avenue, Falls Creek, Pennsylvania, and who has a place of business at 220 S. Brady Street, DuBois, Penna.

(3). The Plaintiff is a nonprofit corporation which furnishes hospital and medical care in the City of DuBois.

(4). Plaintiff at the request of Defendant did on various dates, more specifically outlined in this Complaint, furnish medical services and hospitalization as more specifically outlined in this Complaint to Defendant, to Defendant's wife, Mrs. Wanda Kesslar, and to Defendant's two minor children, Patricia and Robert M. Kesslar.

COUNT ONE

(5). The Plaintiff at the request of Defendant did furnish to Patricia Kesslar, the minor dependent of the Defendant, on September 30, 1958 through October 5, 1958, medical services and hospitalization as outlined on the true and correct copy made from the original books of entry of the Plaintiff marked "Exhibit A",

(6). The charges for medical services and hospitalization were actually rendered, and are just and reasonable.

(7). Plaintiff has demanded payment of the sum due as shown by "Exhibit A", but Defendant has refused and does refuse to pay the same.

(8). Defendant is not entitled to any off-sets, credits, or other deductions except as outlined on "Exhibit A", and the balance as shown on said Exhibit, \$122.65, together with interest, remains due and payable.

COUNT TWO

(9). The Plaintiff at the request of Defendant did furnish to Mrs. Wanda Kesslar and baby boy Kesslar, wife and minor dependent of the Defendant, on September 30, 1959 through October 13, 1959, medical services and hospitalization as outlined on the true and correct copy made from the original books of entry of the Plaintiff marked "Exhibit B", and attached hereto.

(10). The charges for medical services and hospitalization were actually rendered, and are just and reasonable.

(11). Plaintiff has demanded payment of the sum due as shown by "Exhibit B", but Defendant has refused and does refuse to pay the same.

(12). Defendant is not entitled to any off-sets, credits or other deductions except as outlined on Exhibit B, and the balance as shown on said Exhibit, \$464.60, plus interest, remains due and payable.

COUNT THREE

(13). The Plaintiff at the request of Defendant did furnish to Robert M. Kesslar, the minor dependent of the Defendant, medical services and hospitalization from October 27, 1959 through October 29, 1959 as outlined on the true and correct copy made from the original books of entry of the Plaintiff marked "Exhibit C", and attached hereto.

(14). The charges for medical services and hospitalization were actually rendered, and are just and reasonable.

(15). Plaintiff has demanded payment of the sum due as shown by "Exhibit C", but Defendant has refused and does refuse to pay the same.

(16). Defendant is not entitled to any off-sets, credits or other deductions except as outlined on "Exhibit C", and the balance as shown on said Exhibit, \$34.85, plus interest, remains due and payable.

COUNT FOUR

(17). The Plaintiff at the request of Defendant did furnish to Robert Kesslar, the minor dependent of the Defendant, on November 13, 1960, x-ray services as outlined on the true and correct copy made from the original books of entry of the Plaintiff marked "Exhibit D", and attached hereto.


(18). The charge for said x-ray service is just and reasonable, and the service was rendered.

(19). Plaintiff has demanded payment of the sum due as shown by "Exhibit D", but Defendant has refused and does refuse to pay the same.

(20). Defendant is not entitled to any off-sets, credits or other deductions except as outlined on "Exhibit D", and the balance as shown on said Exhibit, \$7.50, together with interest, remains due and payable.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment in the amount of \$629.60, with interest on the component parts.
