report that in pursuance of said order we have reviewed and laid out
and do return for Private use the following road to wit to dotted
lines to be vacated, Beginning near Alexander Murray's fence
Thence North twenty seven and half East fifty two perches Thence North fifty
three and half East six perches Thence North seventy three East twenty perches
Thence North fifty six East six perches Thence North sixty one East thirty
four perches Thence North sixty four East eighty four perches to
the Road up Deer Creek this part is vacated in all ninety two
perches to Deer Creek Thence North twelve East forty four perches Thence
North eighteen West forty four perches Thence North twenty five East
thirteen perches Thence North fifty East eighteen perches to Hays
corner Thence South ~~eighty~~ ^{eighty} West fifty six perches to where turned
into Jannette's field which is vacated as follows North sixty five East

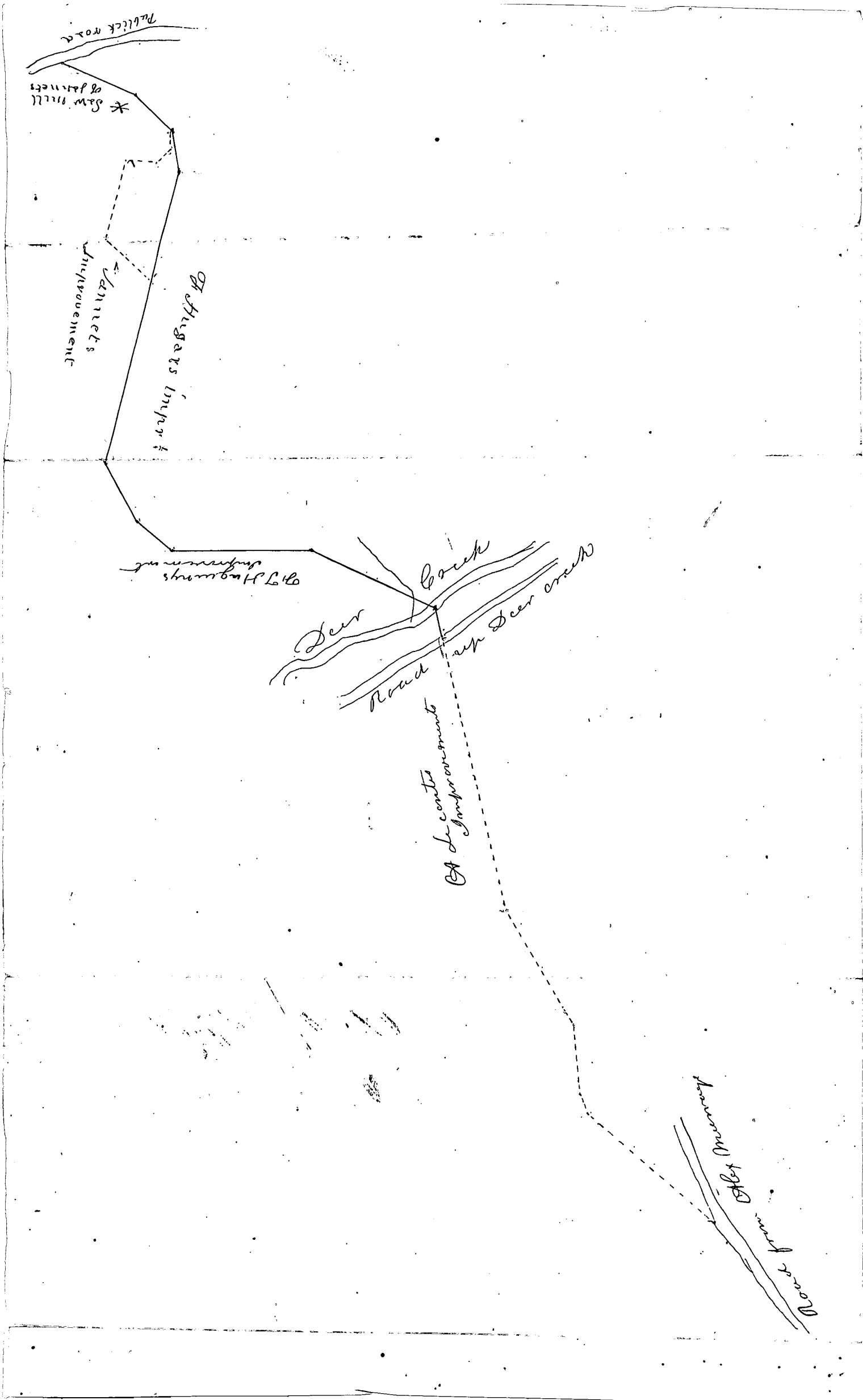

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the *26* day of *June* A. D. 186*6* before the Judges of the said Court upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Union* in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway to lead from *Union Mills* *to or near Alexander Mearns*

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to ^{*view & supply*} view and ~~lay out~~ the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Peter Lamm, Charles Mizerat & Gustav Peck.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to ^{*vacate & supply*} view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
