To the Hon. Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sessions of the County of Clearfield
Pa. at June Term A.D. 1868.

The Petition of the undersigned Citizens
of Pike Tp. & Curwinstown Borough in the
County of Clearfield aforesaid, respectfully
presents.

That a Bridge is necessary
across Anderson's Creek on the line of
the Pennville Turnpike - That said
Creek at the place where the Bridge
ought to be built is the boundary line
between Pike Tp. and the Borough of
Curwinstown, and that the necessary

be too great to be borne by the
aforesaid Tp & Borough. Also that
the said Bridge would be greatly
used by the people of the Southern
or upper part of the County ^{who live} beyond
the said Tp and Borough.

the Bridge at that place be built
at the expense of the County and
declared a County Bridge and that
viewers be duly appointed by your
said Court to view and report according
to law, And so they pray.
