The undersigned Citizens of Lawrence and Gosport
Townships would respectfully ask that the boundary
line between the said Townships be changed, so as
to begin on the Susquehanna River at ^{the North East} the Corner
of Ellis Farm & Sons ^{Respectively} - and Henry Meads
thence north-west along the line between the said
Harms being the division line - and to continue
west on the line of the said Ellis Farm & Sons
as far as the North-East Corner of Farm of
Margery Arden, and there intersect the present
Township line. The reason for this change of line
to afford the Citizens of Gosport Township an oppor-
tunity of having the Road and Bridges under
their control, that now belong to Lawrence Township
and is their only direct Road of communication
to the Town of Cheshire - Hoping you Hon.
will make such order in the premises as you
may judge legal and just to all the Citizens
