COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff above named claims of the above named Defendant upon a cause of action, whereof the following is a statement:

(1). Marguerite M. Twoey, Plaintiff, resides at 321 E. Cherry Street, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, and is the owner of a 1958 Mercury 4-door hard-top automobile.

(2). That Paul Webb, the Defendant above named, resides at 703 S. 11th Street, Newark, New Jersey.

(3). That on the 11th day of September, 1960, at or about 1:30 P. M., the Plaintiff was travelling southeast on Route 322 between the Borough of Clearfield, Clearfield County, and Philipsburg Borough, Centre County.

(4). That the Plaintiff was attempting to make a turn to the east into Wallacetown Borough, when the car driven by the Defendant, Paul Webb, struck the right-rear portion of the Plaintiff's car, causing the damages hereinafter complained of.

(5). That at the time and place of said accident, the Defendant, Paul Webb, admitted to the Plaintiff that he was at fault, and that he was travelling too fast and could not stop.

(6). That the negligence of the Defendant consisted of the following:

- a. in failing to have his car under proper control;
- b. in failing to operate his motor vehicle at such a rate of speed that would be proper under the conditions, then and there existing;
- c. in failing to observe that the Plaintiff's car was turning into the Borough of Wallacetown, in time to permit the Defendant to have his car brought to a stop;
- d. in following too closely to the Plaintiff's vehicle;

e. in attempting to pass the Plaintiff's vehicle at a time and place when it was unsafe to do so;


f. in not exercising due care under the circumstances then and there existing.

(7). That the Plaintiff had her car repaired by the J. E. Hipp Auto Body Shop, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, which repairs amounted to \$217.98, copy of said repair bill being hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A", and made a part hereof.

(8). That repeated demands have been made upon the Defendant to make payment of said bill, without success, hence this suit is brought to recover said sum of \$217.98, with interest from the date of the said accident, to wit, September 11, 1960.
