AND FURTHER, we, the makers and endorsers of this note, jointly and severally, authorize any Prothonotary, or any attorney of any Court of record in Pennsylvania or elsewhere, to confess judgment at any time against us or any of us in favor of the holder hereof for the above sum, with interest as aforesaid, together with the costs of suit and with ten per centum attorney's commission for collection and release of errors and without stay of execution and, for value received, do waive the right and benefit of all exemptions, homestead or otherwise, which we may have under or by virtue of the constitution or of any present or future laws of this or any other state exempting property, real or personal, from levy and sale on execution and, if levy be made on real estate, do also waive the right of inquisition and consent to the condemnation thereof with full liberty to sell the same on Fi.Fa., with release of errors thereon.

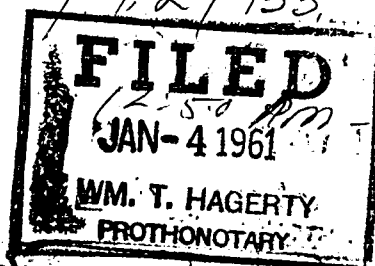
