 Jacob Shuck thence to Henry Auericks and to
 vacate that part from said newly laid out
 road to the Public road leading from the upper
 line to the Dunkelawney and Lutterbush Turn
 pike at the German Church they therefore pray
 the court to appoint persons duly qualified
 to receive the grounds as set forth in this petition
 for a road and to lay out the same according
