

WHEREAS Turbotville Block Co., Inc.

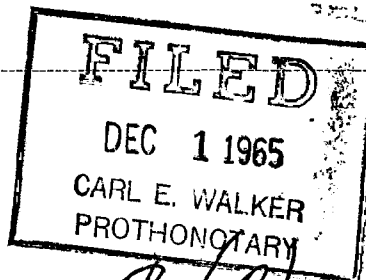


