C O M P L A I N T

(1). The name of the Plaintiff is Robert Leitzinger, a resident of the Borough of Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2). The name of the Defendant is Charles Cozadd, whose last known address or place of residence was 607 Jefferson Street, Hartford, Connecticut.

(3). On or about May 18, 1960, the Plaintiff was a passenger in an automobile being operated in an easterly direction on Route 322 leading from Clearfield to Philipsburg.

(4). On or about the aforesaid date, and when the car in which the Plaintiff was riding, was approximately opposite the Robinson Clay Products Company's plant just east of the Borough of Clearfield, the Defendant was driving a 1959 Chevrolet on said route in a westerly direction.

(5). Said Defendant operated his vehicle in a negligent manner in that he drove said car across the white line and into the path of the vehicle in which the Plaintiff was riding.

(6). The Plaintiff does not know the cause for Defendant's action, but believes and, therefore, avers that it was because the Defendant fell asleep or was paying no attention to what he was doing.

(7). As a result of said accident, Plaintiff suffered a concussion, cuts in and about his face, contusions to his head, and an injury to his back.

(8). As a result of said accident, the Plaintiff bears scars upon his face and has suffered a disc injury to his back, resulting in a permanent disability to the Plaintiff.

(9). As a result of said accident, Plaintiff has expended the following medical expenses:

- A. Doctor bills - \$154.00
- B. Medicine - \$50.00
- C. X-rays - \$40.00

(10). As a result of said accident, Plaintiff will suffer a future loss in wages and incur future medical expenses.

(11). As a result of said accident, the Plaintiff has to date lost \$48.00 in wages.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against the Defendant in a sum in excess of \$5,000.00.
