



ALL that certain lot or parcel of ground situated in the Borough of Ramey (formerly Gulich Township), County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, on the North side of Railraod Street, bounded on the East by Lot No. 78; on the North by Agate Alley; on the West by Lot No. 80; on the South by Railroad Street in the plan of Beulah City, recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania in Deed Book 73 at page 504 thereof, and known as Lot No. 79 in the plan of Beulah City, and having thereon erected a two story frame dwelling house.
