TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

The Petition of Tina Pristas, Pro Se, respectfully represents that:

1. Petitioner's residence is 532 Chestnut Avenue, P.O. Box 281, DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.
2. She is duly licensed to operate motor vehicles in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Operator's License No. 19741696.
3. December 2, 1999, the Director of the Bureau of Driver Licensing, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation, suspended Petitioner's operating privileges effective January 13, 2000, under authority of §1786(d) of the Motor Vehicle Code as indicated on the attached notice which is labeled Exhibit "A".
4. Petitioner has filed an Appeal of the Summary Conviction at the District Justice to the Court of Common Pleas of Fayette County, Pennsylvania, a copy of which is attached hereto, incorporated herein by reference and labeled Exhibit "B".
5. Petitioner was not the registered owner of the vehicle on June 9, 1999, the date of the citation.

Dear Motorist:

Your driving privilege is scheduled to be suspended on 01/13/2000, because you failed to produce proof of financial responsibility on 06/09/1999, the date of your traffic offense.

1. Your driving privilege will be suspended for three months effective 01/13/2000 at 12:01 A.M. as authorized by Section 1786(d) of the Vehicle Code.

Please see the enclosed application for restoration fee information.

2. You will be required to return any current driver's license or learner's permit and/or temporary drivers license (camera card) in your possession.

3. You will be required to provide the Department with proof that all motor vehicles registered in your name are covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or by a program of self-insurance approved by the Department.

You will not be permitted to operate a motor vehicle until you have been advised in writing by this Bureau that your privilege has been reinstated.

If you do not comply with this notice, this Bureau will refer this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under Section 1571 (A) of the Vehicle Code.

EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUSPENSION: 01/13/2000 12:01 A.M.

In order to comply with this sanction you are required to return any current driver's license, learner's permit and/or temporary driver's license (camera card) in your possession no later than the effective date listed. If you cannot comply with the requirements stated above, you are required to submit a DL16LC Form or a sworn affidavit stating that you are aware of the sanction against your driving privilege. Failure to comply with this notice shall result in this Bureau referring this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Vehicle Code.

Although the law mandates that your driving privilege is under suspension even if you do not surrender your license, credit will not begin until all current driver's license product(s), the DL16LC Form, or a letter acknowledging your sanction is received in this Bureau.

WHEN THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES YOUR LICENSE OR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT, WE WILL SEND YOU A RECEIPT. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE THIS RECEIPT WITHIN 15 DAYS CONTACT THE DEPARTMENT IMMEDIATELY. OTHERWISE, YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN CREDIT TOWARD SERVING THIS SANCTION.




