

COMPLAINT

Now, comes the Plaintiff, Tracy J. Yarger who hereby avers as follows:

1. Tracy J. Yarger is an adult individual whose address is RR#1 Box 617 Houtzdale Pennsylvania 16651.
2. Defendant is Brian K. Yarger, an adult individual, whose address is RR1 Box 675-D, Osceola Mills, Pennsylvania 16666.
3. On or about November 06, 1998, at approximately 8pm, Tracy J. Yarger, Plaintiff was the operator or a 1988 Chevy Beretta, in which two passengers, Brian Shane Yarger age 14 and Dustin Shawn Yarger approximately 8 years old were passengers in the vehicle. The vehicle was in a parked, stationary position with its 'fourways' on while waiting on the right side of TR 655, Mease Road, Decatur Twp. Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
4. At the date, time and place referenced, Defendant, Brian Keith Yarger, was the operator of a 1997 Dodge Extended cab Ram 4x4 pickup truck, owned by Plaintiff and Defendant.
5. At the date time and place above referenced, Defendant suddenly and unexpectedly-- without warning, backed the truck from a private driveway in reverse, revving his loud pipes, when from around the shrubs and mailbox you could see reverse lights coming directly into the front of the parked 1988 Chevy Beretta that the Plaintiff and two children occupied which resulted in a collision.
6. The collision was solely and approximately the result of the negligence of the Defendant, which is as follows:
 - A In suddenly, unexpectedly and without warning intentionally backed his vehicle into parked vehicle. Backing his vehicle into stationary parked vehicle occupied by Plaintiff and sons he knew or should have known that

to do so would cause undue risk or collision.

B In continuing to accelerate his vehicle in reverse, in a backing position, t the Defendant's rear bumper impacted the vehicle the Plaintiff was occupying. Defendant then continued to accelerate his vehicle in an attempt to push the vehicle that the victim occupied backwards.

C In violating applicable laws of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code regarding crossing roadways or backing from a private drive and Pennsylvania Vehicle Code Section 3743 ACCIDENTS INVOLVING DAMAGE TO ATTENDED VEHICLE OR PROPERTY (M-3) AND PENNSYLVANIA VEHICLE CODE SECTION 3702. LIMITATIONS ON BACKING(S).

D. In creating a hazardous situation by intentionally backing his vehicle into the Beretta (auto.) the Plaintiff and children occupied, and continuing to accelerate his truck in reverse, leaving the scene without determining the extent of damage or if any injuries had occurred.

E. Police reports states tire track evidence at the scene indicated that vehicle victim and sons occupied was stationary at the time of the collision and had been pushed backwards.


F. It is the opinion of the arresting officer that the Defendant intentionally, knowingly, and recklessly placed the victim and two juveniles in fear of serious bodily injury as stated on the police report of **AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE BY CHIEF NICK RICHTSCHEIT.**

7. As a direct and approximate result of Defendant's negligence as described herein Plaintiff has sustained damages as following:

A. Damage to the right head lamp assembly, hood, aimhead lamps, fender, paint alignment and other miscellaneous damages to the vehicle the Plaintiff occupied in the amount of **\$583.64.**

B. Magistrate costs of **\$53.00** that Plaintiff paid and won Judgement at Magistrate Rudella's, Court of Common Pleas, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania Judicial District 46-3-03 on January 25, 2000.

C. Wherefore Plaintiff demands judgement against Defendant in the amount of **\$636.64**, plus interest, court costs, punitive damages, postage, mileage, document delivery and such other reasonable costs as the court may allow.


