which the said road runs are to take notice.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of Clearfield County Pa.

We the Undersigned Citizens of Lawrence Township, Clearfield County Pa. do respectfully remonstrate against your said Court granting an order to open a road leading from Holf Run in Lawrence Township to Ellis Irvin Mill in Goshen Township. Which road as we understand, leaves the township road, (leading from Clearfield town to Kuthans) at Holf Run and has been viewed around the River Susquehanna to Ellis Irvin Mill where it again intersects the Township road aforesaid. The object of said road being made for the following reason:

1. That, there has been a view of a road leading from Clearfield to Kuthans passing said Irvin, confirmed by said Court, and an order taken out and a portion of said road opened and at Sept. Sessions A.D. 1868 an alias order was granted by your said Court on said view, to open another part of said road as viewed, beginning at a point at or near James Irvin Sen, and terminating at or near Ellis Irvin in Goshen township; which road when made, will accommodate, and answer all the purposes for which the road around the River is intended to do. -

2. That, the making of a road around the River will be much longer than the road as viewed for which the alias Order was granted, and will therefore

be attended with a very great expense, the greater part of it being along the slope of the hills that border the River. Which expense will almost entirely have to be borne by the citizens of Lawrence Township.

3. That, there are no persons living in the neighborhood of said proposed road to be benefitted, except those who already have a good road leading to the public road aforesaid, and we therefore believing that a road in that locality will be a useless expense to the citizens of Lawrence Township, do remonstrate against the confirmation of the plan of said road and the granting of an order.
