

8. Plaintiff has been advised that counseling is available and that Plaintiff may have the right to request that the Court require the parties to participate in counseling.



AND NOW, the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2000, the Plaintiff and Defendant having filed Affidavits of Consent stating that the marriage is irretrievably broken and that ninety (90) days have elapsed from the date of the service of this Complaint and Waivers of Notice of Intention to Request Entry of Divorce Decree having been filed;

We, therefore, DECREE that ROBERT N. O'LEARY, be divorced and forever separated from the nuptial ties and bonds of matrimony heretofore contracted between himself and JOAN O'LEARY. Thereupon all the rights, duties or claims accruing to either of said parties in pursuance of said marriage, shall cease and determine, and each of them shall be at liberty to marry again as though they had never been heretofore married.


