COUNT I - DIVORCE/IRRETRIEVABLE BREAKDOWN 3301(c)

1. That the Plaintiff, DENNIS W. COYLE, is an adult individual who is presently residing at R. D. 1, Box 133, Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 16833.
2. That the Defendant, DONNA M. COYLE, is an adult individual who is presently residing at c/o Tina McFarland, Owens Street, Kerr Addition, Clearfield, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania 16830.
3. That Plaintiff and Defendant have been bona fide residents in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for at least six (6) months immediately prior to filing this Complaint.
4. That Plaintiff and Defendant were married on November 4, 1989, in the State of New Jersey.

5. That there were two children born of this marriage, namely, Dennis W. Coyle, Jr. (d.o.b. 7/6/89), and Stanley A. Coyle (d.o.b. 11/19/90).

6. There has been no prior action for divorce or annulment instituted by either of the parties in this or any other jurisdiction.

7. That there has been an irretrievable breakdown of the marriage relationship of the parties within the meaning of Act. No. 26 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Section 3301(c).

8. That the Plaintiff has been advised of availability of counseling and the right to request that the Court require the parties to participate in counseling.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests your Honorable Court to enter a decree in divorce, divorcing the Plaintiff and Defendant absolutely.

9. That Paragraphs One (1) through Eight (8) of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.



PETITION FOR SPECIAL RELIEF

COMES NOW, Defendant-Petitioner, Donna M. Coyle, through counsel, MIDPENN
LEGAL SERVICES, INC., with her *Petition for Special Relief* pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. No. 1915.13
("Actions for Custody-Special Relief") requesting that she be granted an *ex parte* order for
custody of the minor child VEDA SIJALKOWSKI and that her *Complaint for Custody* be set
expeditious for a hearing/conference and as grounds states:

1. Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure Number 1915.13 reads in pertinent part: "at any time after commencement of the action, the court may ... grant appropriate interim or special relief." Pa.R.C.P. No. 1915.13 ("Actions for Custody-Special Relief").
2. Under this rule, the Court has broad power to fashion remedies for the just and speedy resolution of issues that would promote the best interests of the children. Pa.R.C.P. No. 1915.13 Explanatory Note – 1981. Such relief would include remedial orders, appropriate *ex parte* action, and scheduling matters for priority or expeditious handling.
3. This matter was originally filed with regard to the custody of Dennis Coyle, Jr., and Stanley Coyle, the minor children of Plaintiff Dennis Coyle and Defendant Donna Coyle.
4. Defendant Donna Coyle has an older child to a previous relationship, VEDA SIJALKOWSKI (15 years old), that has resided with Plaintiff Dennis Coyle and Defendant Donna Coyle for approximately the last ten years.
5. VEDA SIJALKOWSKI's natural father is Thomas George Bowers, Jr.; however, VEDA SIJALKOWSKI has not seen her natural father for several years.
6. Although Plaintiff Dennis Coyle is not VEDA SIJALKOWSKI's natural father, he

likely has standing to participate in a custody matter concerning VEDA
SIJALKOWSKI.


7. VEDA SIJALKOWSKI visited with Plaintiff Dennis Coyle at his home on July 13, 2000. Since that time, VEDA SIJALKOWSKI has been in his possession. Plaintiff Dennis Coyle refuses to permit Defendant Donna Coyle to see or talk with the child.
8. While the child has been in Plaintiff's care, her conduct has not been appropriately supervised. She has been permitted to date men 21 years of age or older and to remain out until the late evening and even early morning hours. She does not have appropriate care or supervision of her conduct ~~for~~ when she is in the care of Plaintiff.
9. Defendant Donna Coyle is and has been the primary caretaker of the child her entire life, even when the parties were residing together.
10. Although some continued contact with Plaintiff is probably appropriate for the child's relationship to Plaintiff as her step-father and father-figure, primary custody of the child should be with Defendant Donna Coyle.
11. It is appropriate to resolve the custody dispute concerning VEDA SIJALKOWSKI under this existing custody action between the parties and to join VEDA SIJALKOWSKI's natural father, Thomas George Bowers, Jr., as a third party defendant to the action.
12. Along with this *Petition for Special Relief*, Defendant-Petitioner Donna Coyle has simultaneously filed her *Complaint for Custody*.
13. It is in the best interest of the minor child that primary custody be granted to Plaintiff-Petitioner and that any contact with Defendant-Respondent be restricted to supervised visits as Defendant-Respondent is unable to appropriately care for the child on his own ~~and has demonstrated a resistance to complying with specific court orders without supervision~~.
14. Consistent with the local practice rules of the Clearfield County Court Rule No. 206(d) (Court of Common Pleas of Clearfield County, 46th Judicial District, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Rules of Civil Procedure; 46 J.D.R.C.P. Rule 206) regarding procedures for *ex-parte* relief, counsel for Plaintiff has attempted to notify Defendant of its intent to present this *Petition*.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff-Petitioner requests that this Court enter an appropriate *ex-parte* order granting primary custody of VEDA SIJALKOWSKI to her and restricting contact between VEDA SIJALKOWSKI and Plaintiff periods of time as restricted and regulated by Defendant Donna Coyle; and that the underlying *Complaint for Custody* be set for

hearing/conference as expeditiously as the Court's schedule will allow.
