Wilhelm fence, then same course 36 perches to middle Township road thence along said road South 22 degrees West 55 perches to White Oak thence through land of Wm Smeal, & Henry Smeal South 22° W 144 perches to middle fence of Len Hubler then fence of Hubler South 79 degrees West 36 perches to Township road a plot or draft whereof is hereto annexed. Which said road we return as public road.

We further report no damages.

Mitchell*

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Wm D. Bigler, C. M. Hyler and Levi Herber.

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
