6. Mr. Walko has caused to be posted with the District Magistrate proper bond for stay of execution pursuant to District Justice Rule of Civil Procedure 410.



OPINION AND ORDER

William A. Shaw

This matter comes before the Court on a Petition for Leave to Appeal Nunc Pro Tunc from the District Justice's decision on a civil complaint wherein the Justice entered judgment against the Petitioner. Defendant-Petitioner failed to appear for the hearing scheduled by the District Justice and did not appeal from the judgment within 30 days from date of entry. In his Petition he alleges that he received no proper notice of filing of the complaint or of the hearing. The record from the Magistrate's office indicates service of notice was attempted by certified mail but was returned marked "unclaimed." Thereafter, the complaint was served on the Defendant's wife at her place of business in the City of DuBois, Pennsylvania. The Defendant claims improper service because his wife was not served at their residence or at an office or usual place of business of the Defendant.

Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 308 provides for service of the complaint on an adult member of the Defendant's family at his residence. But as stated in Goodrich-Amram, the basic purpose of the rule is to assure that a Defendant will receive actual notice of a commencement of action against him and of his duty to defend. Since the rules provide that service upon the Defendant's spouse is proper notice to him, it would appear to be immaterial whether the service takes place at the Defendant's residence or elsewhere as the primary purpose of the rule is satisfied by serving the Defendant's wife.

WHEREFORE, the Court enters the following:

ORDER


