

They explained to me that the car was still on record, but in the name of Lynn C Hitchens, who is the person that traded it in at Auto Motorville.

My efforts to contact Lynn C Hitchens were Thwarted when I tried to send a letter, and it was returned to sender.

For these reasons I am now requesting the court to issue a Pennsylvania title.
