COUNT ONE - Divorce

1. Plaintiff is MICHAEL A. STIVER, whose current mailing address is RR #1, Box 503, LaJose, PA 15753, Clearfield County, State of Pennsylvania.

2. Defendant is TAMARA LEE STIVER, who currently resides in Irvona, PA with a mailing address of P.O. Box 483, Coalport, PA 16627, Clearfield County, State of Pennsylvania.

3. MICHAEL A. STIVER and TAMARA LEE STIVER have been a bona fide resident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a period of more than six (6) months immediately preceding the filing of this Complaint.

4. The parties were married on October 18, 1986 in LaJose, PA.

5. The parties have four unemancipated children, namely Michael A. Stiver II, D.O.B. 04/26/87; Brandon L. Stiver, D.O.B. 05/14/92; Anthony C. Stiver, D.O.B. 11/23/88; and Zachary H.

Stiver, D.O.B. 06/15/99.

6. Neither of the parties were previously married.

7. There has been no prior action for divorce or annulment instituted by either of the parties in this or any other jurisdiction.

8. The plaintiff has been advised that counseling is available and that plaintiff may have the right to request that the Court require the parties to participate in counseling.

9. The marriage is irretrievably broken.

10. The parties separated on August 2, 2000 when defendant left the marital residence.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff respectfully requests the Court to enter decree of divorce pursuant to §3301(c) of the Pennsylvania Divorce Code.

COUNT TWO - Custody

11. The prior paragraphs of this Complaint are incorporated herein by reference thereto.

12. The parties are the parents of the following unemancipated children one of whom resides with plaintiff: i.e. Michael A. Stiver II, D.O.B. 04/26/87.

13. The parties are the parents of the following unemancipated children three of whom reside with defendant: i.e. Brandon L. Stiver, D.O.B. 05/14/92; Anthony C. Stiver, D.O.B. 11/23/88; and Zachary H. Stiver, D.O.B. 06/15/99.

14. The children from their respective dates of birth until

August 2, 2000 have resided with both parties.

15. On August 2, 2000 defendant left the marital residence and began residing at Irvona PA with Kathy Bloom and her son.

16. When defendant left the marital home she took the three youngest children with her and they reside there to this day.

17. The oldest child has refused to move with his mother and wants to remain in the primary custody of his father.

18. Plaintiff has not participated in any other litigation concerning the children in this or any other state.

19. There are no other proceedings pending involving custody of the children in this or in any other state.

20. Plaintiff knows of no person not a party to these proceedings who has physical custody of the child or who claims to have custody, partial custody or visitation rights with respect to the child.


21. The best interest of the children requires that they be placed in the primary physical custody of the plaintiff as he is better suited emotionally and by disposition to care for them and is better able to guide them physically and spiritually.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff respectfully requests that, pursuant to §§3104(a)(2) and 3323(b) of the divorce code, the court enter an order awarding primary physical custody of Michael A. Stiver II, D.O.B. 04/26/87; Brandon L. Stiver, D.O.B. 05/14/92; Anthony C.

Stiver, D.O.B. 11/23/88; and Zachary H. Stiver, D.O.B. 06/15/99 to him.

AND NOW, comes the Defendant, Tamara Lee Stiver, by and through her attorney,

R. Denning Gearhart, who avers as follows:

1. Admitted.
2. Admitted.

5. Admitted, except that the child Zachary H. Stiver has a date of birth of June 14, 1999.

8. Not within the knowledge of the Defendant, and, therefore, neither admitted or denied.

10. Admitted that the parties spearated on August 2, 2000. Regarding the implication that the Defendant voluntarily left the marriage residence, it is denied. In fact, she was constructively evicted by the Plaintiff by his abusive actions and words.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant joins with the Plaintiff in the request for a divorce decree pursuant to Section 3301(c) of the Pennsylvania Divorce Code.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests that the Court deny Plaintiff's request for primary physical custody.

COUNTERCLAIM

AND NOW, comes Tamara Lee Stiver, by and through her attorney, R. Denning Gearhart, who files a Counter-claim as follows:

22. That Paragraphs 1 through 21 of the Complaint and Answer thereto are incorporated herein by reference as if fully averred.

23. That throughout the marriage the plaintiff has been physically and sexually abusive to the Defendant.

24. That at times this abuse resulted in the neglect of the children by the Plaintiff and an inability to attend to the children by the Defendant.

25. That since the parties separated, the Plaintiff has been erratic in communicating with the three sons still living with the mother and has refused to them adequate support.

26. That since the parties separation, the oldest son, who is allegedly living with the Plaintiff, has been left with his grandparents and has been neglected by the Plaintiff.

27. That on August 30, 2000, when the oldest child was in the supposed care and custody of the Plaintiff, he did suffer a broken thumb for which the Plaintiff refused to seek medical treatment until several hours later when forced to do so by the Defendant.

28. That in addition to the above reasons, the best interests of all of the said children would be served by granting to the Defendant primary physical custody as she is better able to provide for the physical, mental, emotional and spiritual well being of said children.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests your Honorable Court to grant to her primary physical custody of Michael A. Stiver, II (d.o.b. 4/26/87), Brandon L. Stiver (d.o.b. 5/14/92), Anthony C. Stiver (d.o.b. 11/23/88), and Zachary H. Stiver (d.o.b. 6/14/99).

ALIMONY

29. That Paragraphs 1 through 28 of the Complaint, Answer and Counterclaim are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

30. That Defendant lacks sufficient property to provide for her reasonable means and is unable to support herself and her children consistent with the standard of living established during the marriage.

31. That Defendant requires additional support for herself and her children to adequately maintain herself and her children in accordance with the standard of living established during the marriage.

32. That Plaintiff is currently employed by Gallaher Supply, Inc., Irvona, Pennsylvania, and it is believed that he earns in the neighborhood of Three Thousand Dollars per month.

33. That Defendant is unemployed and has been unable to retain employment due to the interference by the Plaintiff.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests your Honorable Court to enter an award of reasonable alimony.

ATTORNEYS FEES AND COSTS

34. That Paragraphs 1 through 33 of the Complaint, Answer and Counterclaim are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.

35. That Plaintiff has employed R. Denning Gearhart, Esq., as counsel, but is unable to pay the necessary and reasonable attorney's fee for said counsel.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests your Honorable Court to enter an award of preliminary counsel fees, costs and expenses until final hearing and thereupon award such additional counsel fees, costs and expenses as are deemed appropriate.

EQUITABLE DISTRIBUTION

36. That Paragraphs 1 through 35 of the Complaint, Answer and Counterclaim are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth in full.


37. That Plaintiff and Defendant have legally and beneficially acquired both real and personal property during the course of their marriage.




MOTION FOR COUNSEL FEES AND COSTS

2. The mother shall have primary physical custody of Brandon Lee Stiver, Anthony C. Stiver and Zachary H. Stiver.



4. Transportation shall be provided as agreed to between the parties.



Transportation arrangements and periods of partial custody pertaining to Holidays, Birthdays, school vacations, and summer vacations shall be as agreed between the parties.


