At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield,
held at Clearfield town, in and for said county, on the *18* day of
June A. D. 186*8* before the Judges of the said Court upon
the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of *Lawrence*
in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience
for the want of a road or highway to lead from *the public*
road near J. G. Scheyers to the
river at a point opposite Second
Street in Clearfield Borough

Report as to Damages

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. **Whereupon** the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

W. C. Foley M. Pomeroy J. L. Cutler

who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road, and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly, whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.

The undersigned officers appointed to view, measure & supply
any change in the annexed order required. respectfully

Report. That in pursuance of the duty enjoined upon them by
said order that they went upon the ground, and found the property on which
said road is laid, all run off into town lots for building with streets & alleys -
and that the road proposed to be changed runs across said lots - We after
viewing the ground adopted the street known as Nichols Street in the place
of "West Clearyfield". Beginning at the end of the Bridge now in course
of erection, thence North eighty eight and three quarter degrees West, one hundred
and two perches to ~~township road~~ ^{part} to line of land of J. G. Schryver - thence by
land of J. G. Schryver North twenty four and one half degrees west six perches
to township road, and we recommend that the same be confirmed for public use -
Also that that ^{part} of the old township road from corner of J. G. Schryver's land
bearing South ~~Twenty~~ ^{Twenty} degrees East and extending to the township road at the
river be vacated. No Damages assessed. The proprietors of "West Clearyfield"
waiving all claims to damages. And we further say that were duly
affirmed according to law and time & place of meeting advertised.
