AND NOW, comes DOROTHY E. LANG ROOT, by and through her
attorney, R. DENNING GEARHART, who avers as follows:

1. That Plaintiff is DOROTHY E. LANG ROOT, a widow, with an
address of
2. That Defendant, NELLIE ROOT SCHRAND, is an adult individual,
with a last known address of 400 N. Erie Street, Bay City, Michigan.
3. That Defendant, BLODWREN SHRAND HUBER, is an adult
individual, with a last known address of 3250 Cross Key Dr. #5, Florissant, Missouri
63033.
4. That Defendant, JANE SCHRAND, is an adult individual, with a last
known address of Bay City, Michigan.
5. That the property in question is more particularly described below
and has the Tax Map No. 11-H16-350-00012:

ALL those three certain piece or parcel of land situate in the township of Beccaria, County of Clearfield and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone corner of the grantor and H.L. McCoy and on line of S.C. Shoff; thence by the H.L. McCoy line North five degrees (5) East seventy-three (73) rods to a Cherry corner; thence by land of the grantor, South eighty-six degrees and thirty minutes East seventy-two and two tenths (72.2) rods to a sugar; thence by land of the Grantor, South sixty-five degrees (65) East thirty-one and two tenths (31.2) rods to a post on the right of way of Public Road leading from Beccaria to Madera; thence by said right of way South twelve degrees and thirty minutes West six and four tenths (6.4) rods; thence by the same South twelve degrees and thirty minutes East twenty-two and six tenths (22.6) rods; thence by the same South four degrees (4) fourteen (14) rods; thence by the same South twenty degrees and thirty minutes West twenty-two and eight tenths (22.8) rods to a post; thence by line of S.C. Shoff North eighty-five degree (85) West ninety-nine and four tenths (99.4) rods to the place of beginning, containing forty-five acres and fifty-four perches neat measure.

5. That said property was purchased by J.C. Root by Deed from R.P. Root and Mary M., husband and wife, dated September 12, 1913 and entered for record in the Recorder's Office of Clearfield County to Deed Book Volume 196, Page 275.

6. That said J.C. Root died January 19, 1941. An estate was opened to Estate File No. 17601 with the Register of Wills Office of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania on January 28, 1941.

7. There were four children born to J.C. and Rhoda Jane Root, his wife, namely, Nellie Root, Harvey L. Root, J. Russell Root and Lloyd D. Root.

8. That Rhoda Jane Root is believed to have passed away in 1918, leaving to survive her her husband, J.C. Root and the above named four children.

9. That according to the Last Will & Testament of J.C. Root, the rest, residue and remainder of his estate is given devised unto his three remaining children, Harvey J. Root, J. Russell Root and Nellie P. Schrand.

10. That Nellie Root married Charles Schrand who she then divorced. There were two children born of this marriage, namely, Blowdyn Schrand and Jane Schrand.

11. Jane Schrand is believed to have passed away in 1947 leaving no spouse, nor issue.

12. That Harvey L. Root is known to have passed away October 17, 1947 leaving no spouse, nor issue. In accordance with intestate succession, the property passes in equal shares to his surviving siblings, J. Russell Root and Nellie Schrand.

13. J. Russell Root married Blodwen Williams, both whom have since passed away. They parented one child, namely, John Lloyd Root.

14. John Lloyd Root married Dorothy Lang. John Lloyd Root passed away August 13, 1995 with title thereby vesting in his surviving spouse, Dorothy Lang Root. They parented two children, namely, Richard L. Root and David J. Root.

15. Lloyd D. Root is known to have passed away, predeceasing his father, J.C. Root.

16. That with respect to this property, Plaintiff and her predecessors in title have exercised open, notorious and continuous dominion possession and control over the premises described in Paragraph 5 for a period in excess of 21 years adverse to any other claims of ownership.

17. That with respect to this property, Plaintiff and her predecessors in title believed this was conveyed to her and as a result of that belief, she has maintained it by paying taxes thereon.

18. That the purpose of this Quiet Title Action is to extinguish and cure any defects which may exist in the ownership of property more particularly described in Paragraph 5 hereof, and to extinguish any equity which the Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns may have in the premises described in Paragraph 5 hereof.

19. That the Defendant, her heirs, successors and assigns identified in Paragraph 2, 3 and 4 of this Complaint are the only persons or entity known to Plaintiff who have any interest in said property and the Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns cannot be determined if he/they continue(s) to exist. All the public records in the Clearfield County Courthouse and local telephone books have been checked prior to reaching this conclusion.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs request:

A. that by decree of your Honorable Court it be declared that title to the premises set forth in Paragraph 5 is in the Plaintiff and that she be allowed to enjoy said property in peace;

B. that the Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of this Complaint, institute an action of ejectment against the Plaintiff and that otherwise the Defendants, their heirs, successors and assigns be perpetually enjoined from setting up any title to said property from impeaching, denying or in any way attaching the Plaintiff's title to said property, from issuing or maintaining an ejectment from said premises and from encumbering, mortgaging or conveying the said premises or any part thereof.

C. such other relief as the court determines to be equitable and just.
