



COMPLAINT

AND NOW, comes Gerald Royer d/b/a/t/a Royer's 219 Auto Sales, by and through its attorneys, The Hopkins Law Firm, and states as follows:

COUNT I – BREACH OF CONTRACT

1. Plaintiff, Gerald Royer, is an individual who operates a business known as Royer's 219 Auto Sale at R.D. #1, Box 104 DuBois, Pennsylvania 15801.

2. The Defendant is Thomas McGilton who maintains a principal business address at 1710 East High Street, Waynesburg, Pennsylvania 15370.

3. At all material times hereto both Plaintiff and Defendant operated used car dealerships.

4. On December 14, 1999, Plaintiff purchased a 1997 International 4700/T444E rollback truck from the Defendant.

5. The sale certificate certifies that the vehicle had been driven 68,242 miles as of December 14, 1999.

6. At all material times hereto, Defendant represented the vehicle had been driven 68,242 miles. Defendant made those representations with the knowledge that

Plaintiff would rely upon that information in deciding whether to purchase the motor vehicle at the price asked by Defendant.

7. Relying upon the aforesaid representations by Defendant, Plaintiff did purchase the motor vehicle.

8. On January 14, 2000, Plaintiff presented the vehicle to an International Navistar dealer who placed the vehicle on their diagnostic computer. The truck's computer identified the correct odometer reading as 95,636 miles when the truck's odometer reading then read 70,474.

9. When Plaintiff purchased the motor vehicle, the vehicle had been driven 25,162 more miles than Defendant had represented same had been driven.

10. As a result of the additional mileage, the vehicle is worth at least \$6,000.00 less than what Plaintiff had paid for same and the vehicle is now out of warranty which further diminishes the vehicle's value.

11. The actions of the Defendant constitute breach of contract for which Plaintiff has suffered damages.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant Thomas McGilton, Thomas McGilton, for compensatory damages, cost of suit, pre and post judgment interest and such other and further relief as the Court deems fair, just and equitable.

COUNT II- CONSUMER FRAUD

12. Plaintiff repeats all of the allegations set forth in Count I of this Complaint as if set forth at length herein.

13. The actions of the Defendant constitute consumer fraud within the meaning of the Pennsylvania statutes.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands damages against Defendant, Thomas McGilton, for compensatory damages, treble damages, cost of suit, pre and post judgment interest and such other and further relief as the Court deems fair, just and equitable.

COUNT III – COMMON LAW FRAUD

14. Plaintiff repeats all of the allegations set forth in Count I and Count II of this Complaint as if set forth at length herein.

15. At all material times hereto, Defendant knew the representations that the vehicle had been driven only 68,242 miles as of December 14, 1999 were false.

16. Defendant made the aforesaid statements anticipating Plaintiff would rely upon same. Plaintiff did rely upon said statements in purchasing the motor vehicle.

17. The actions of the Defendant constitute fraud, entitling Plaintiff to an award of punitive damages.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff demands judgment against Defendant Thomas McGilton, for compensatory damages, punitive damages, cost of suit, pre and post judgment interest and such other and further relief as the Court deems fair, just and equitable.

COUNT IV – RESCISSION OF CONTRACT

18. Plaintiff repeats the allegations set forth in Counts I through III of this Complaint as if set forth at length herein.

19. At all material times hereto, one or both parties was mistaken as to the miles the vehicle had been driven as of December 14, 1999. As a result of said failure to

know the mileage which the vehicle had been driven, there was not a meeting of the minds between Plaintiff and Defendant as to the purchase of the motor vehicle described herein.

20. The parties did not have a contract.

21. Plaintiff respectfully requests this Honorable Court rescind the contract between Plaintiff and Defendant and obligate Defendant to repay Plaintiff all monies which Plaintiff paid on behalf of the motor vehicle including tax, title and license fees in exchange for returning the motor vehicle to Defendant.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff respectfully requests this Honorable Court rescind the contract between Plaintiff and Defendant and obligate Defendant to repay Plaintiff all monies which Plaintiff paid on behalf of the motor vehicle including tax, title and license fees in exchange for returning the motor vehicle to Defendant.

DEMAND FOR JURY TRIAL

Plaintiffs demand a trial by twelve jurors on all issues presented herein.
