**PETITION OF APPEAL FROM ORDER OF  
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
SUSPENDING DRIVER'S LICENSE**

The Petition of Richard W. Burnsworth respectfully represents as follows:

1. Your Petitioner is Richard W. Burnsworth, who resides at 409 Curtin Street, Borough of Osceola Mills, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. Your Petitioner's Operator Number is 23403991.
3. On June 23, 1998, your Petitioner received a Citation for making an improper U-turn in York County, Pennsylvania. The fine was \$92.50 which Petitioner paid by postal money order.
4. The District Justice's Office has no record of said payment and reported the fine as unpaid in July 1998.
5. During the summer of 2000, when your Petitioner's employer was applying to various insurance carriers for vehicle insurance prices, an insurance carrier notified your Petitioner that PennDOT records indicated that your Petitioner's Operator's License was suspended.
6. Your Petitioner immediately investigated the reason for the suspension and found it was a report that the 1998 fine in York County was unpaid.

7. Your Petitioner contacted the District Justice in York County and as a result, the York County violation was dismissed.

8. Your Petitioner assumed this corrected the problem with his driver's license.

9. On September 4, 2000, your Petitioner was cited in State College, Centre County, Pennsylvania, for disregarding a traffic control device. At that time, he was also cited for driving while his operating privileges were suspended. Copies of said Citations are attached hereto as Exhibits A and B.

10. Your Petitioner contacted PennDOT to ascertain why his license was suspended and he was advised that he was required to pay a \$75.00 reinstatement fee.

11. Your Petitioner promptly paid the reinstatement fee.

12. By letter, dated October 20, 2000, your Petitioner received notification from PennDOT that his license was being suspended for violation of 75 PA C.S.A. 1543 (A), driving while under suspension. A copy of said Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

13. An Official Notice of Suspension dated October 23, 2000, was sent to your Petitioner. A copy of said Official Notice is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

14. Your Petitioner appeals said Notice of Suspension dated October 23, 2000, based on the following:

(a.) The suspension was based upon the non-payment of the 1998 York County violation which was in fact paid.

(b.) Your Petitioner was never given any notice that his driver's license was suspended as a result of the 1998 violation.

(c.) When your Petitioner learned of the license suspension in the summer of 2000 and removed the basis for the suspension, he was not advised that anything additional was required


to have his license reinstated.

(d.) When your Petitioner was cited on September 4, 2000, he had no reason to know his license was still under suspension.

(e.) Since he had no knowledge of the continued suspension, he lacked the necessary intent to violate 75 PA C.S.A. 1543 (A).

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner requests your Honorable Court grant a hearing de novo of the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Notice of Suspension and that an Order be issued scheduling a hearing and staying all proceedings pending said hearing and granting such other relief as the Court deems appropriate.
