LICENSE SUSPENSION APPEAL

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGE JOHN REILLY, PRESIDENT JUDGE:

Defendant, Tina Darlene Starr, by and through her undersigned counsel, moves this Court to grant her a hearing upon the merits of the following License Suspension Appeal:

1. Defendant was sentenced on June 27, 2000, having entered guilty pleas to aggravated assault, assault by vehicle while driving under the influence, a felony of the second degree, homicide by vehicle, a misdemeanor of the first degree, driving under the influence, a misdemeanor of the second degree and summary offenses;
2. Defendant is currently incarcerated in the Clearfield County Jail and is on work release which is providing her with the opportunity to remain productive and generate income so that she can pay the costs of prosecution, supervision under the direction of the Clearfield County Department of Probation Services, Adult Division and fines related to her sentence;
3. Defendant has been notified by mail by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Bureau of Driver Licensing on October 24, 2000 that her license was being suspended for a period of six months effective 11/28/2000 at 12:01 a.m., a copy of said notice attached as "Defendant's Exhibit One";

4. Defendant requests a hearing upon the validity of the imposition of this license suspension prior to her being paroled;

5. Taking away the Defendant's license at this time will make it impossible for her to continue on work release as she does not have any other way to get to work unless she drives herself;

6. The filing of this appeal should act as a supersedeas and restrict the Department of Transportation from suspending the Defendant's driver's license until final disposition of this appeal;

WHEREFORE, the Defendant would request that this court disallow the Department of Transportation to suspend the Defendant's license for the reasons herein suggested;



Dear MS. STARR:

This is an Official Notice of the Suspension of your Driving Privilege as authorized by Section 1532B of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code. As a result of your 06/27/2000 conviction of violating Section 3736 of the Vehicle Code RECKLESS DRIVING on 12/29/1998:

- Your driving privilege is SUSPENDED for a period of 6 MONTH(S) effective 11/28/2000 at 12:01 a.m.

Before PennDOT can restore your driving privilege, you must follow the instructions in this letter for COMPLYING WITH THIS SUSPENSION, PAYING THE RESTORATION FEE and PROVIDING PROOF OF INSURANCE. You should follow ALL instructions very carefully. Even if you have served all the time on the suspension/revocation, we cannot restore your driving privilege until all the requirements are satisfied.

COMPLYING WITH THIS SUSPENSION

You must return all current Pennsylvania driver's licenses, learner's permits, temporary driver's licenses (camera cards) in your possession on or before 11/28/2000. You may surrender these items before, 11/28/2000, for earlier credit; however, you may not drive after these items are surrendered.

YOU MAY NOT RETAIN YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR IDENTIFICATION PURPOSES. However, you may apply for and obtain a photo identification card at any Driver License Center for a cost of 9.00. You must present two (2) forms of proper identification (e.g., birth certificate, valid U.S. passport, marriage certificate, etc.) in order to obtain your photo identification card.

You will not receive credit toward serving any suspension until we receive your license(s). Complete the following steps to acknowledge this suspension.

1. Return all current Pennsylvania driver's licenses, learner's permits and/or camera cards to PennDOT. If you do not have any of these items, send a sworn notarized letter stating you are aware of the suspension of your driving privilege. You must specify in your letter why you are unable to return your driver's license. Remember: You may not retain your driver's license for identification purposes. Please send these items to:

2. Upon receipt, review and acceptance of your Pennsylvania driver's license(s), learner's permit(s), and/or a sworn notarized letter, PennDOT will send you a receipt confirming the date that credit began. If you do not receive a receipt from us within 3 weeks, please contact our office. Otherwise, you will not be given credit toward serving this suspension. PennDOT phone numbers are listed at the end of this letter.
3. If you do not return all current driver license products, we must refer this matter to the Pennsylvania State Police for prosecution under SECTION 1571(a)(4) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

PAYING THE RESTORATION FEE

You must pay a restoration fee to PennDOT to be restored from a suspension/revocation of your driving privilege. To pay your restoration fee, complete the following steps:

1. Return the enclosed Application for Restoration. The amount due is listed on the application.
2. Write your driver's license number (listed on the first page) on the check or money order to ensure proper credit.
3. Follow the payment and mailing instructions on the back of the application.

PROVIDING PROOF OF INSURANCE

Within the last 30 days of your suspension, we will send you a letter asking that you provide proof of insurance at that time. This letter will list acceptable documents and what will be needed if you do not own a vehicle registered in Pennsylvania.

Important: Please make sure that PennDOT is notified if you move from your current address. You may notify PennDOT of your address change by calling any of the phone numbers listed at the end of this letter.


APPEAL

You have the right to appeal this action to the Court of Common Pleas (Civil Division) within 30 days of the mail date, OCTOBER 24, 2000, of this letter.
