COMPLAINT

AND NOW come the plaintiffs, Lanny Bloom, Sylvan Bloom and Gerald Bloom, who by and through their attorney, John R. Carfley, Esquire, bring this action against Mid-East Oil Company, and in support thereof set forth the following:

1. Plaintiff, Lanny Bloom, is an adult individual, presently residing at P. O. Box 13, New Millport, Pennsylvania, 16861.

2. Plaintiff is Sylvan Bloom, an adult individual, presently residing at P. O. Box 13, New Millport, Pennsylvania, 16861.

3. Plaintiff is Gerald Bloom, an adult individual presently residing at 2519 Dunhaven Glen, Snellville, Georgia, 30278.

4. Defendant, Mid-East Oil Company, is a duly licensed drilling company, identification number 87845, with a principal place of business located at P. O. Box 1378, Indiana, Pennsylvania, 15701.

5. By deed dated August 20, 1990 and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, in Record Book Volume 1445, page 182, Plaintiffs acquired title to the parcel of land located in Pike Township, Clearfield County,

described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the Western boundary line of the "John Ladd Howell Warrant" of which this is a part, at the intersection thereof with the northern right of way line of the New York Central Railroad, Beech Creek Division, about one-fourth (1/4) mile East of "New Millport" Station; thence by the Western line of said warrant, being the line of Ferguson Township, North four (4) degrees and seven (7) minutes East for a distance of two thousand eight hundred and sixty-three and four-tenths (2863.4) feet to a stone at the public road; thence by said public road along lands formerly sold to Elizabeth Williams North thirty-five (35) degrees and forty-two (42) minutes East for a distance of nine hundred and fifty-seven (957) feet; thence by same North thirty-two (32) degrees and forty-seven (47) minutes East for a distance of three hundred thirteen and five-tenths (313.5) feet; thence still by the same North twenty three (23) degrees East for a distance of two hundred and sixty four (264) feet to a point in the northern line of the Warrant and line of lands of Jennie Bloom; thence by said line South eighty-six (86) degrees and twenty-seven (27) minutes East for a distance of six hundred (600) feet to a point, the northern end of the line dividing said warrant in two parts; thence by said division line and lands now of Lex Starr, Perry Bowman and B. C. and K. L. Erhard, South four (4) degrees and twelve (12) minutes West for a distance of four thousand five hundred and forty-one (4541) feet to a point in the northern right of way line of the New York Central Railroad, Beech Creek Division; thence by said northern right of way line, being thirty-three (33) feet from the center line of said railroad, measured at right angles thereto, North seventy-six (76) degrees and ten (10) minutes West for a distance of one thousand three hundred and fifty-two and eight-tenths (1352.8) feet to the point in the western line of the "John Ladd Howell Warrant" and the place of beginning. Containing one hundred eighteen and nine-tenths (118.9) acres of land careful measurement.

A true and correct copy of the aforementioned deed is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

6. Prior deeds in Plaintiffs' chain of title include two exception and reservation clauses that read as follows:

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING therefrom a certain piece or parcel of land, the same being bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a post on the South side of Township Road leading from Olanta to New Millport four hundred and sixteen (416) feet East of the Ferguson Township line; thence over lands of the Grantors South four (4) degrees seven (7) minutes West, five hundred (500) feet to a post corner; thence over lands of the Grantors North thirty-five (35) degrees forty-five (45) minutes East, five hundred (500) feet to a post corner; thence still over lands of the Grantors, North four (4) degrees seven (7) minutes East, five hundred (500) feet to Township Road leading from Olanta to New Millport; thence along the South side of said Township Road, its several courses and distances West, five hundred (500) feet more or less to post on said Township Road and place of beginning. Containing in all about six (6) acres, more or less.

ALSO EXCEPTING AND RESERVING from the above described two (2) pieces or parcels of land all the coal, fire-clay, other minerals, oil and gas, with the right of ingress, egress and regress into, through and upon the above described lands for the purpose of examining, searching for, prospecting, mining, manufacturing and preparing said coal, fire-clay, other minerals, oil and gas for market, and taking, storing, removing and transporting the same, and for these purposes the said Grantors shall have the right to mine and remove the said coal, fire-clay, other minerals, oil and gas, according to any and all known and modern methods, including the right to strip the surface (together with the right of using and occupying so much of the surface of the lands for drifts, headings, openings, shafts, air-shafts, tipples, dumps, chutes, railroads, roads, lateral railroads, electric power or transmission lines, improvements and other buildings) except miners houses upon, over and across and through said lands and the surface of the same so far as may be necessary or convenient for the proper working of any mine or mines for the removal of said coal, fire-clay, other minerals, oil and gas, or the shipping of the same, together with the right to deposit dirt or waste from such mine or mines upon the surface thereof, with a full and complete release of any and all damages that may result to the surface, buildings thereon erected, springs, meters, or any other damages that may be done in the exercise of the rights herein reserved, or any of them, and which may result from the mining and removal of the coal, fire-clay, other minerals, oil and gas from the said lands.

7. It is believed and therefore averred that by subsequent assignment of the excepted mineral rights, defendant acquired certain rights to the oil and gas reserves located beneath the

surface of the subject property.

8. By various letters dated between September 13, 2000, and September 18, 2000, Defendant notified Plaintiffs of its intention to drill several gas wells throughout the aforementioned property. True and correct copies of the said letters are attached hereto as Exhibits B-1 - B-6.

9. At least four of the sites for the Defendant's gas wells are located in the southern portion of the subject property within managed forest areas that have been previously contracted to Brookville Wood Products, Inc. (hereinafter "BWP").

10. Under the terms of the contract between the Plaintiffs and BWP, BWP has the exclusive right to remove all marketable timber located on the property through May 30, 2002. A true and correct copy of the said contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "C".

11. Defendant has already begun to perform activities in preparation for the drilling of the proposed gas wells including but not limited to bulldozing roadways to provide ingress and regress to the proposed well sites, the leveling of timber within the area of the proposed well sites, and the removal of ground surface for the placement of pipeline.

12. Each of the well sites will result in the Defendant taking approximately one square acre of the Plaintiffs' property.

13. Defendant's activities are causing Plaintiffs and their assigns immediate and irreparable harm and interfering with their ability to enjoy the benefit of ownership or the enjoyment or use of the property.


14. Pennsylvania law mandates that the right of an owner of the mineral estate to access a mineral estate must be reasonable and not prevent the owner of the surface estate from the enjoyment or use of his property.

15. By planning to drill wells throughout the entire parcel of land and already removing timber and ground surface from the Plaintiffs' property, Defendant's actions are not reasonable and have and will continue to deprive the Plaintiffs and/or their assigns from the use and enjoyment of their property.

16. As such, Plaintiffs request a determination be made into the reasonableness of the Defendant's drilling activities and a measure of the potential damages for which Plaintiffs would be entitled.

WHEREFORE, plaintiffs request this Honorable Court to enter judgment declaring Defendant's drilling operation unreasonable and further determine as a result of Defendant's unreasonable use of the surface the amount of damages for which Plaintiffs would be entitled.

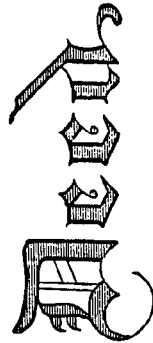

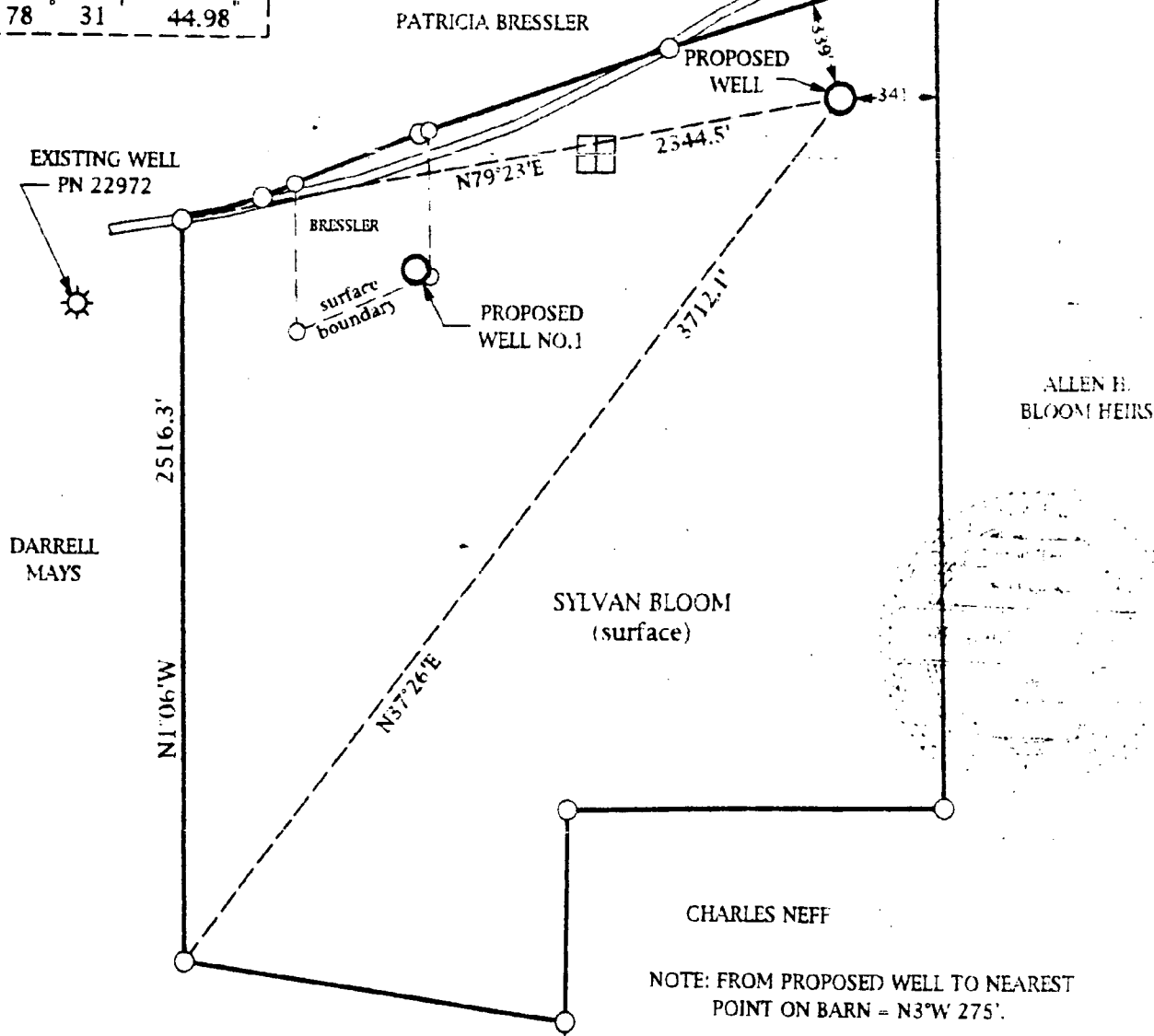

WELL LOCATION PLAT

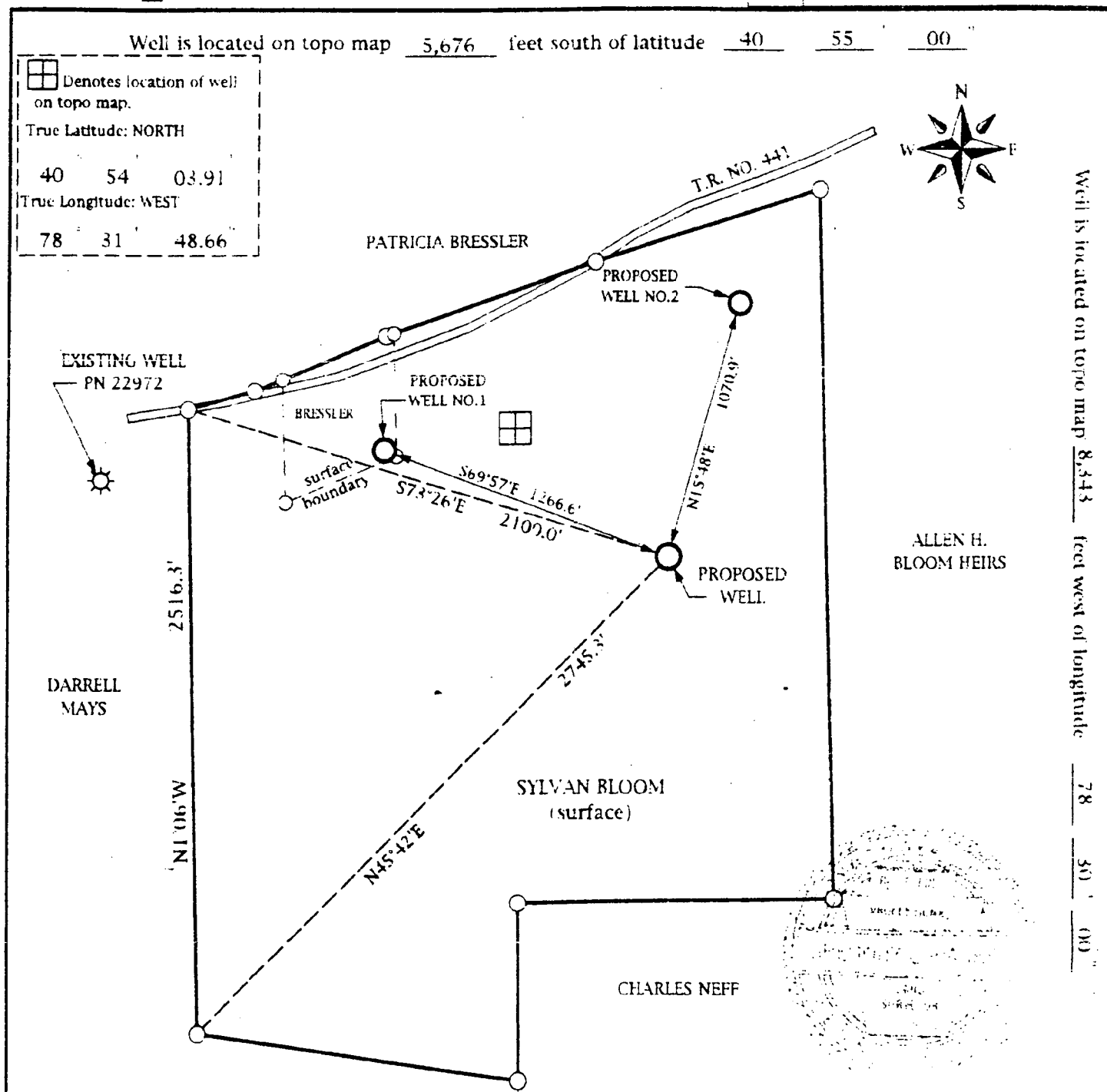



WELL LOCATION PLAT

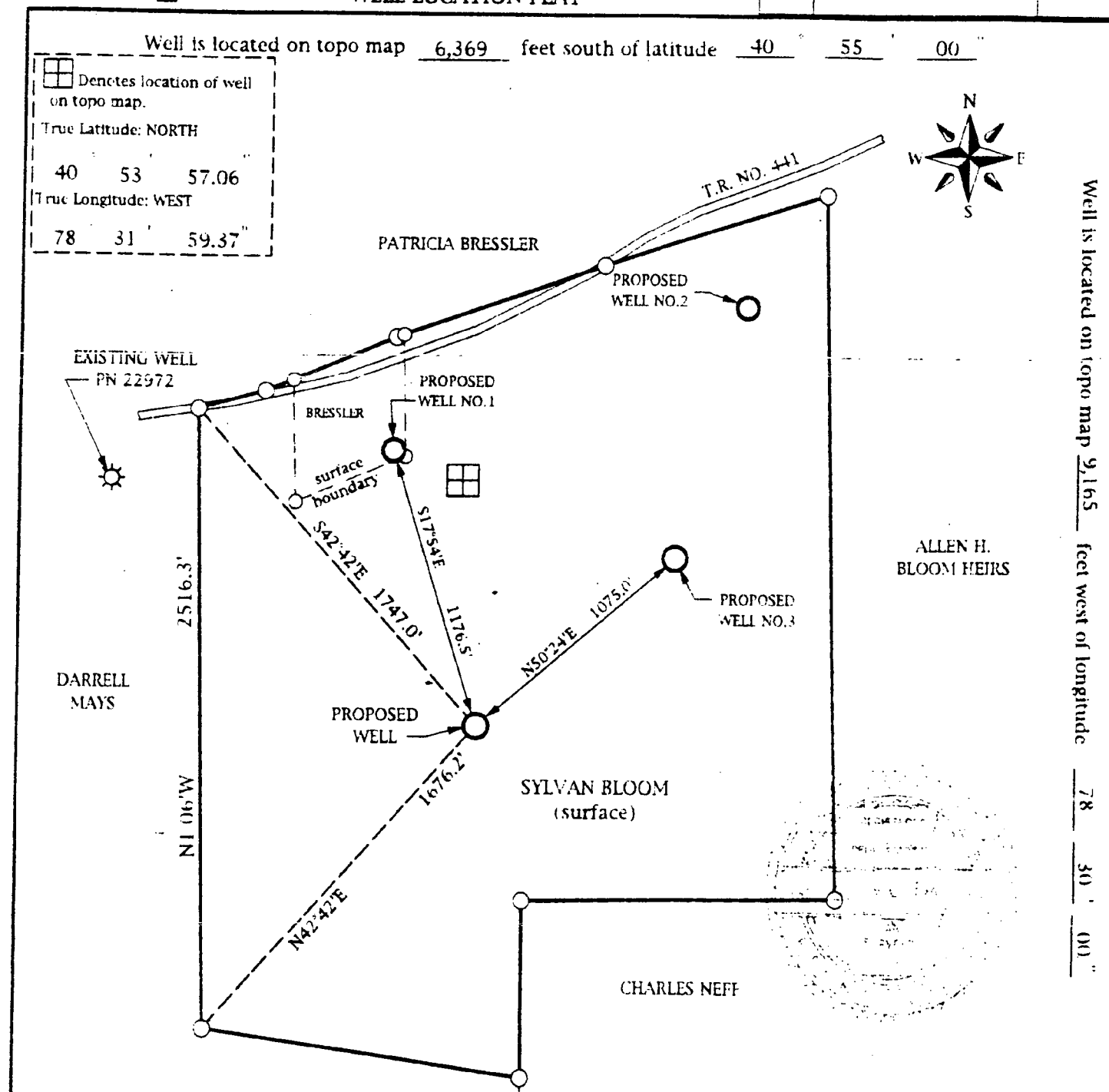
