COMPLAINT

AND NOW, come the Plaintiffs, KAREN J. ARAVICH and DONALD E. ARAVICH, through their Attorney, David P. King, and for their cause of action respectfully represent as follows:

1. The Plaintiffs are KAREN J. ARAVICH and DONALD E. ARAVICH, of 1160 Treasure Lake, DuBois, PA 15801.

2. The said KAREN J. ARAVICH and DONALD E. ARAVICH are wife and husband.

3. The Defendant is PENN TRAFFIC COMPANY, a corporation, tdba BI-LO FOODS, with one of its principal places of business being at the Main Street Mall, which is in DuBois, Clearfield County, PA.

4. The said PENN TRAFFIC COMPANY, tdba BI-LO FOODS, at all times relevant hereto, did operate a supermarket business at the address above mentioned, a supermarket selling groceries, food and related products to the general public at retail.

5. On or about November 11, 1999, the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, did enter the said supermarket operated and owned by the

Defendant at said location, for the purpose of purchasing fruit and perhaps other products in accordance with the general invitation of the Defendant to her and other persons as a member of the general public.

6. Upon entering the said supermarket on the date as mentioned, and at approximately 4:10 o'clock P.M., the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, did then proceed to the produce department in order to purchase the fruit and/or other products that she was seeking.

7. As your Plaintiff proceeded, and as she reached her destination within the confines of said supermarket, the Plaintiff realized and discovered that the premises was under some sort of construction.

8. As a result of the construction which was on going, certain conditions existed within the supermarket which was open to the general public and particularly to your Plaintiff as an invitee, including but not limited to the following:

- (a) Poor lighting;
- (b) Darken conditions;
- (c) Flooring partially torn up;
- (d) Dust in the air;
- (e) Boxes and debris strewn about;
- (f) Contractor's equipment in the immediate vicinity;
- (g) Plastic sheeting hung throughout;

- (h) Boxes of fruit or other products lying on the floor and in the aisles;
- (i) Boxes under display cases; and
- (j) Attractive-distractive displays.

9. In addition to all of the above, when your Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, entered the said premises, there were no verbal cautions or warnings given to her, nor was there any store personnel in the vicinity attempting to assist, guide or otherwise insure the safety of business invitees such as your Plaintiff.

10. Under such conditions, the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, did attempt to retrieve and obtain the fruit that she had come to purchase at the establishment of the Defendant, and in doing so, her foot caught on a box that was not visible, and was sitting under a display case in the immediate vicinity.

11. As a result of all of the same, the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, lost her footing, causing her to fall, and during such fall struck her head and skull upon boxes and/or the display case, striking her right eye, and suffering permanent injury to the same.

12. As a result of her fall and said injury generally described above, your Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, required medical care and attention immediately, and thereafter.

13. Additionally, as a result of her injury as above described, the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, also suffered wage loss as well as an impairment which will cause loss of earnings to her in the future.

14. Additionally, the Plaintiff, KAREN J. ARAVICH, has undergone pain, suffering, discomfort and the loss of depth perception, and the ability to judge distances, all of which continues to date, and is expected to continue definitely, and permanently into the future.

15. In addition to medical bills incurred, Plaintiff has also incurred some nominal costs for child care expenses because of her inability to care for her children during the times immediately following her injury.

16. Additionally, Plaintiff's husband, DONALD E. ARAVICH, has lost time and money as a result of having to be off work and tend to the duties and tasks usually performed by his wife.

17. Further, the Plaintiff, DONALD E. ARAVICH, has undergone a loss of consortium as a result of the injuries to his wife.

18. Plaintiffs further aver that the injuries and losses suffered by them were the direct result of the negligence of the Defendant which consisted of the following:

- (a) Failing to maintain their business premises in a safe condition for its customers and business invitees such as KAREN J. ARAVICH;
- (b) Failure to properly warn, in writing or otherwise, the customers and business invitees such as KAREN J. ARAVICH of the dangerous conditions that existed upon the premises all of which are above described;

(c) Allowing all of those conditions to exist as above mentioned as a pitfall and distraction to unwary customers and business invitees such as KAREN J. ARAVICH;

(d) The failure to have personnel directing, and otherwise protecting the customers and business invitees upon the premises such as KAREN J. ARAVICH;


(e) The failure to clean up, or otherwise remove such distractions and hidden pitfalls such as those above described which caused and led to the injuries of the Plaintiff;

(f) The failure to maintain the business environment during regular business hours in a safe condition by providing inadequate lighting, and allowing dust to cloud, distract and otherwise conceal or distract unwary customers such as Plaintiff; and

(g) Failure to otherwise and in general exercise due care under all of the circumstances and for all of the reasons and facts as set forth herein.

WHEREFORE, the Plaintiffs pray your Honorable Court to enter judgment in their favor and against the Defendant for medical bills, pain and suffering, permanent loss, out of pocket expenses,


