1. Your Petitioners are the duly elected members of
the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Lawrence, County of
Clearfield, Pennsylvania.

2. Certain roads have heretofore been dedicated as
public roads and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the center of the intersection of
Legislative Route 17084 and Township Road T519;
thence North 88° 55' West, a distance of Eight
Hundred Thirty Nine and One-tenth (839.1) feet.
The said road being Thirty Three (33) feet in
width and more fully described in the print
attached.

3. That all of the owners of the abutting real estate
have petitioned the Board of Supervisors of Lawrence Township to
take over the said road and which Petition or Request is hereto
attached.

4. That the said road has been used as a means of
access to and from the properties abutting on the same and has

been used by the public for more than twenty one (21) years.

5. It would be advantageous to the owners of the abutting properties and to the Township of Lawrence to accept said road as part of the public road system of Lawrence Township.

6. That your Petitioners by virtue of the Second Class Township Code have accepted the said road as part of the public road system by resolution adopted at a regular meeting held October 5, 1961.

THEREFORE, your Petitioners pray your Honorable Court to approve the acceptance of the said road herein described and issue an Order authorizing the same to be added to and included in the road system of Lawrence Township.



ORDINANCE - NO. 1 - 1962
BY COOPER TOWNSHIP SUPER-
VISORS OF CLEARFIELD COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, TO LAY OUT,
OPEN AND DEDICATE AS A PUBLIC
STREET OF SAID TOWNSHIP, CER-
TAIN PREMISES HEREINAFTER
DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, 53 Purdon's Pennsylvania Statutes Annotated
§ 66101; (1956, June 1, P.L., (1955) 2021 § 13); granted the
power unto the Township Supervisors to lay out, open and ordain
by Ordinance roads within the Township within statutory limit-
ations; and

WHEREAS, certain interested citizens of the Township have
petitioned the Supervisors to lay out, open and dedicate a cer-
tain road or street in said Township as a public street; and

WHEREAS, It is the intention of the Cooper Township
Supervisors by the following Ordinance to enact, ordain and lay
out as a public street or road in said Township premises herein-
after described; and

WHEREAS, the said Township Supervisors have viewed favor-
ably the aforesaid petition presented by certain citizens of
Cooper Township who desire to have the aforesaid premises opened,
laid out, dedicated and ordained as a public street and to become
a part of the network of public roads and streets in said Town-
ship.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDAINED by

the Supervisors of Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, in meeting assembled this 8th day of January, 1962 as follows:

(1) That Grassflat Avenue in the Village of Grassflat, Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, extending from the Northern intersection of Grassflat Avenue and Clearfield Street, or Township Route 862, in a Northeasterly direction for a distance of two hundred (200') linear feet and fifty (50') feet in width or breadth; a map of said premises outlined in red of the premises hereinbefore described is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof, is hereby ordained, laid out and opened as a public road or street and shall hereby become a part of the public network of streets and roads in Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, and shall hereafter be known as "THE LUTHERAN CHURCH STREET EXTENSION OF GRASSFLAT AVENUE", in the Village of Grassflat, Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

(2) That in accordance with 53 Purdon's Pennsylvania Statutes Annotated § 66102 (a) ten (10) days' written notice has been given to all of the property owners hereby affected when and where said parties may meet and be heard.

(3) That in accordance with 53 P.S. § 65741 this Ordinance, or an abbreviation thereof, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in Clearfield County.

(4) ENACTED as an Ordinance by the Road Supervisors of Cooper Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, at a Public Meeting or Assembly held by the aforesaid Supervisors this 8th day of January, 1962.

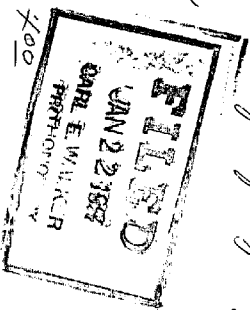
