

On 10/17/68, [redacted] advised that he had been contacted by a person who claimed to be a member of the Black Panther Party (BPP) and was interested in obtaining information regarding the activities of the BPP in the Los Angeles area. The individual stated that they were currently working on a project related to the BPP's operations and needed assistance in gathering intelligence. [redacted] provided the following information:

The individual mentioned that they were looking for someone who could provide them with details about the internal structure and membership of the BPP in Los Angeles. They also expressed interest in learning about the group's financial resources and its relationships with other organizations or individuals.

[redacted] advised that he had discussed this matter with his superiors and they had decided to provide the requested information to the individual. However, it was emphasized that all information provided must be accurate and reliable, and that no sensitive or classified information should be disclosed without proper authorization.

The individual thanked [redacted] for his assistance and promised to keep him updated on the progress of their project. [redacted] concluded the conversation by reminding the individual to maintain confidentiality and to report back as soon as possible.
