TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of Joseph Truhlik respectfully represents:

(1). That he is the father of a child born at the Clearfield Hospital on October 31, 1959; and in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, to No. 17 February Sessions, 1960, he was ordered to pay for the support of said child the sum of \$17.50 for each two-week period.

(2). That said child was placed under the custody of the Juvenile Court and your Honorable Court, under Order dated December 12, 1960, directed that said Kevin Lynn Truhlik should remain with Mrs. Caroline Gavlock, R. D. #3, Clearfield, Pennsylvania, and under the supervision of the Clearfield County Child Welfare Services.

(3). That on September 5, 1960, to the above number and term, your Petitioner filed a Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus, and under Order dated September 23, 1960, your Honorable Court directed that said child should remain under the supervision of the Child Welfare Services, and stated that the Order was a temporary Order.

(4). That later your Honorable Court permitted said child to spend a few days with your Petitioner and his present wife, your Petitioner having divorced Gloria Larson Truhlik in a divorce proceeding in Clearfield County to No. 119 May Term, 1960.

(5). That your Petitioner has not seen or had custody of his child for a long period of time and sincerely requests that he be given an opportunity to have the child in his home in the City of Warren, State of Pennsylvania, for a sufficient period of time to enable them to become better acquainted; and your Petitioner would request that he be allowed such visit for a period of at least six months as the child is of pre-school age, and your Petitioner desires to

have the said child for as long as permitted by your Honorable Court.

(6). That your Petitioner has only had custody of said child since he was born for a period of one or two weeks and during such time your Petitioner bought clothes and underclothes for the said child, and the child was happy and content.


(7). That upon his last return to Clearfield County, your Petitioner was not able to locate said child and understood that said child was at the home of his ex-wife's mother, Mrs. Zemba, and also understood that the child was with his mother part of the time and with Mrs. Gavlock part of the time.

(8). That your Petitioner is regularly employed by the Warren Times Mirror at a salary of \$100.00 per week, has a home, and at the first hearing submitted a letter from his employer, a doctor, and others in the City of Warren as to his behavior and good character.

(9). That your Petitioner's home was formerly in the Borough of Curwensville, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, where his family still resides.


(10). That your Petitioner would be satisfied to have your Honorable Court provide that he be given temporary custody of said child and that the Court request the Child Welfare Service of Warren County to investigate and check on the treatment given the child while in the home of your Petitioner.



PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

The Petition of Joseph Truhlik respectfully asks that custody of his son be taken from his former wife, Gloria Larson Truhlik, and left with he and his second wife for the following reasons:

- (1). That Joseph Truhlik was originally a resident of Curwensville Borough and married Gloria Larson, a resident of Lawrence Township, on the first day of May, 1959.
- (2). That Gloria Larson Truhlik was born on December 21, 1939 and is now 21 years of age.
- (3). That your Petitioner obtained a divorce from his wife in Clearfield County to No. 119 May Term, 1960.
- (4). That they were married in Allegheny County on the first day of May, 1959, and the said Gloria Larson Truhlik left her husband and returned to Clearfield County. Said divorce being obtained on the grounds of indignities.
- (5). Kevin Lynn Truhlik was born in the Clearfield Hospital on October 31, 1959.
- (6). That your Honorable Court to No. 17 February Sessions, 1960 ordered Joseph Truhlik to pay \$17.50 each two-week period for the support of his said son, and since that time, has been making payments regularly.
- (7). That the said Gloria Larson Truhlik did not have custody of said child, having left the child with one, Caroline Gavolok, R. D. Box 182, Clearfield, Pennsylvania.
- (8). That your Petitioner has married again, ~~and his second wife is unable to have children~~ and it is the desire of your Petitioner that he obtain custody of the child that his wife had placed with Caroline Gavolok.
- (9). That said Gloria Larson Truhlik, prior to her marriage, had given

birth to a child, which was adopted, and as a juvenile, had been committed by your Honorable Court to an institution. She has admitted that she was arrested for stealing jewelry in New York State, and at the judgment of your Petitioner, she is not a proper person to have custody of said child.

(10). That your Petitioner has been advised that on the 17th day of August, 1961, the Child Welfare Service took the child from said Caroline Gavolok and delivered it to the said Gloria Larson Truhlik, and that the payments, which your Petitioner has been making to the Probation Office, will now be paid to the mother.

(11). Your Petitioner also advised that the said Gloria Larson Truhlik is now residing in Clearfield Borough near the Clearfield Hospital. The exact address he has been unable to ascertain.

(12). That your Petitioner and his wife, believing that the said Gloria Larson Truhlik will not provide a fit and proper place for said child, and that they have a home in the City of Warren and State of Pennsylvania, 1 Wood Street, Warren, Pennsylvania, are desirous of having custody of said child delivered to them.

(13). That your Petitioner is employed at Warren Times Mirror , at a salary of \$100.00 per week and has a fit and proper home in which to maintain his said child.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that a hearing be had in the above entitled case, after which your Honorable Court shall make such Order as the facts would justify.

**PETITION**

TO THE HONORABLE JOHN J. PENTZ, PRESIDENT JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

The Petition of JOSEPH TRUHLIK, respectfully represents:

(1). That originally a Petition was presented to your Honorable Court by Joseph Truhlik, asking that custody of his son born to his former wife, Gloria Larson be turned over to him.

(2). That after a preliminary hearing, your Honorable Court on the 23rd day of September, 1961, made an Order, placing the child under the control and direction of the Child Welfare Service of the County Institutional District. Said Order stated that the said Joseph Truhlik, having seen his child but twice, and having originally denied paternity thereof, no change would be made for the present time. The child has continued since that date to remain with its mother, Gloria Larson in Kerr Addition.

(3). That your Petitioner has learned since the last hearing, that there were 2 Juvenile Orders made with respect to the said child. Your Petitioner has no knowledge as to what proceeding was brought in the Juvenile Court, but had been advised of a Juvenile Order, Juvenile Docket 5, dated July 12, 1960, which Order directed that Kevin Lynn Truhlik should remain with Mrs. Caroline Gavelok, Clearfield, R. D. 3, and that all payments should be made through the Probation Office to Mrs. Gavelok, and that the child should not be removed from the Gavelok home.

(4). It has also been discovered, that prior to the last Petition for Habeas Corpus, that an Order was filed in the Juvenile Court, removing the child from Mrs. Caroline Gavdok's custody, and placing it with its mother, Gloria Larson, said Order being dated on or about August 16, 1961.

(5). That your Petitioner has had custody of said child, under an Order of your Honorable Court for several weeks, having returned the child to the custody of the mother in Kerr Addition, on Saturday, November 25th.

(6). That your Petitioner has learned since the last hearing, that his child has been in the Childrens' Home at Clearfield at various times, and has learned that, since the last hearing, his wife, on several occasions, has not been in a position to care for said child as a result of which, he is informed that Mrs. Caroline Gavelok, as well as his former-wife's father and uncle, are willing to testify that in their judgment, the welfare of the child would be advanced by its being placed with your Petitioner.

(7). That your Petitioner has attached hereto, a letter from the Warren County Child Welfare Service, as to the fitness of he and his present wife and their home in Warren County, Pennsylvania. At the previous hearing, there was submitted, a letter from the Minister of the E. U. B. Church, a letter from a medical doctor, and a letter from Petitioner's employer.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner respectfully requests your Honorable Court to hold an additional hearing, setting out that said child should be placed with your Petitioner, as that would be in the child's best interest. Your Petitioner has no objection to the child remaining under the custody and control of your Honorable Court, but believes that the child is reaching the stage where a regular and steady home is essential, and that during the period in which the child has been with its mother, it has not had a regular home, but has been left around from place to place.

Dear Mr. Bell:

Our first contact with Mr. & Mrs. Truhlik was on September 20, 1961, when they came to the agency for information related to the custody of Mr. Truhlik's child, Kevin Lynn. Since the first meeting, we have had numerous contacts with the Truhliks by phone and have had the opportunity to have a short visit in their home.

Mr. Truhlik is employed on a full time basis by a Warren County newspaper, The Times-Mirror. They have an adequate, well-furnished seven-room home on 1 Wood Street, Warren, Pennsylvania and appear to have a fairly stable home life. During these contacts, we have related to the Truhliks that we would be willing to work with them on a personal basis in regard to this custody problem if they thought it necessary; also, we would make a full evaluation of their personalities and their home conditions on the request of the Clearfield County Court, if the Court could see this to be a value in this case. Up to this time, we have not been requested by the Court to make this study. However, we are still more than willing to proceed on the Court's request.

In the event that the child is placed with the Truhliks, we would be willing to offer supervision if this would be a consideration of placement.

NOW, September 23, 1961, after hearing on the petition for custody of the child known as Kevin Lynn Truhlik, considering the testimony taken, considering the previous investigations, reports and findings concerning the mother, Gloria Truhlik, and considering the child has been in the custody, control, and direction of the Child Welfare Services of the County Institutional District, such custody and control will continue, and the child be under the supervision and direction of the Child Welfare Services, and continue until further Order.

The support Order heretofore made, to be carried out.

It appears to the Court further, that the petitioner having seen the child but twice, and having denied paternity, has brought this petition for custody, possibly to enable himself to obtain relief from the Court Order. No change will be made for the present at least. The child is not yet old enough to understand the moral situation. If this condition of immorality continues, further change will have to be made later on, as the child gets older and has a little more understanding. The child will be under the sole supervision of the Child Welfare Services for the present.






