STIPULATION AGAINST LIENS

particularly bounded and described as follows:



NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between the said parties, as part
of the said contract and for the consideration therein set forth, that neither the undersigned contractor, nor
sub-contractor or materialman, nor any other person furnishing labor or materials to the said contractor
under this contract shall file a lien, commonly called a mechanic's lien, for work done or materials
furnished to the said building or any part thereof.

This stipulation is made and intended to be filed with the County Prothonotary within ten (10)
days after date, in accordance with the requirements of Act of Assembly of Pennsylvania, in such case
provided.

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the westerly line of Orange Street, formerly Orange Alley, said iron pin also being at the northeast corner of land devised to John Petrillo by Will of Mike Petrillo; thence along the northerly line of said land devised to John Petrillo North $62^{\circ} 25'$ West 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along the easterly line of land of Jack H. and Betty McGinnis North $27^{\circ} 23'$ East 30 feet to an iron pin; thence south $62^{\circ} 25'$ East 60 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Westerly line of Orange Street formerly Orange Alley South $27^{\circ} 23'$ West 30 feet to an iron pin and place of beginning.

BEING a portion of the same premises that were conveyed to Michael Petrillo and Lucille Petrillo, husband and wife, by Deed of Mary J. Brockbank, dated April 17, 1969, and recorded in Deed Book No. 546, Page 599, on April 29, 1969. The said Lucille Petrillo having died the same remained unto the said

Michael Petrillo. The said Michael Petrillo, a/k/a Michael Petrillo, Sr., died testate on July 22, 1984, and by his last Will, duly probated in the Register of Wills Office of Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, on July 26, 1984, devised the above premises to his son, George F. Petrillo.
