

are the undersigned, persons appointed by the
within Order of County, to view, and lay out
the Road therein mentioned, Respectfully

Report, that having given notice of the time, and place, of the view of said Road, according to the Act of Assembly, and having all been present at the view of the ground proposed for such Road, and having all been first, severally sworn and affirmed in pursuance of said Order, we have viewed, and laid out, and do return, the following Road. To wit: Beginning at a Post, corner of George Doney & David Dressler, on the line of Daniel Brupaker, Thence on the line between Dressler & Doney, South Eighty Seven Degrees East, One hundred & nine perches to a Post in the public Road by the Stony Ridge School House. A. Draft whereof is hereto annexed -

which said Road, so as aforesaid laid out, we are of opinion is necessary for a public Road.

ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 1st day of October, A. D. 1868, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Varian, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want of a road or highway leading from the farm of Daniel Bumbaker to the Township road at Stoney Ridge school house,

Report as to Damages

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. H. Arnold, Martin H. Luther and A. J. McClassen who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
