in accordance with certain plans and specifications, and for the furnishing and providing of materials and labor
necessary therefor upon a plot of ground being all that certain piece or parcel of land situate in Lawrence
Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, more particularly described on the attached
sheet.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated and agreed by and between the said parties as part of the said
Contract and for the consideration therein set forth, before any of the above construction is commenced, that Con-
tractor, for himself, herself, itself, themselves, his, her, its and their subcontractors, and all parties acting through
or under him, it or them, covenants and agrees that no mechanics' claims or liens shall be filed or maintained by
him, them, or any of them against the buildings and the lots of ground appurtenant thereto, or any of them, for or
on account of any work done or materials furnished by him, them or any of them, under this contract or otherwise,
for towards, in or about the erection and construction of the said buildings, or any of them, and Contractor, for
himself, herself, itself, themselves, his, her, its and their subcontractors, and others under him, her, it or them,
hereby expressly waives and relinquishes the right to have, file, or maintain any mechanics' lien or claim against
the buildings or any of them, and that this agreement waiving the right of lien shall be an independent covenant
and shall operate and be effective as well with respect to work and labor done and materials furnished under any
supplemental contract, verbal or written, or contract for extra work in the erection and construction of the said
buildings as to work and labor done and materials furnished under this contract.

This stipulation is made and intended to be filed with the CLEARFIELD County Prothonotary
in accordance with the requirements of the Act of Assembly of this State in such cases made and provided.
