

And now, comes ROBERTA A. WANK, the above entitled Plaintiff, by her Attorneys Gleason, Cherry & Cherry, and brings this Complaint in Divorce of which the following is a statement:

1. That the Plaintiff, ROBERTA A. WANK, is an individual residing at 5 Denton Avenue, DuBois, Pennsylvania.
2. That the Defendant, JOHN L. WANK, is an individual residing at U.S. Navy Base, Port Lyauty, French Morroco, Africa.
3. That neither the said Plaintiff and Defendant are natural born citizens of the United States.
4. That neither the said Plaintiff nor the said Defendant is a minor or is incompetent.
5. That said Plaintiff has resided in Pennsylvania continuously for the past one and one-half years, and does, at the present time, reside in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

7. 
