COMPLAINT

Now comes the Plaintiff, by her attorneys, Bell, Silberblatt & Swoope, upon a cause of action, the following whereof is a statement:

1. The Plaintiff is an adult individual, residing at Philipsburg, R. D., Box 250, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. The Defendant is an adult individual, residing in the Village of Munson, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
3. On October 17, 1957, Plaintiff was the owner of a 1949 Ford coupe which was being operated by Robert Greenawalt on U. S. Highway Route No. 322 in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania in a westerly direction.
4. At the time and place aforesaid, the Defendant was operating his motor vehicle at the intersection of U. S. Route No. 322 and Legislative Route No. 177122.
5. At the intersection of said Route No. 322 and Legislative Route 177122, there is a stop sign, requiring vehicles operating on said Legislative Route to stop before entering on to U. S. Route No. 322.
6. Defendant herein did come from said intersection and from Legislative Route 177122 and started to enter Route No. 322, in an attempt to go in an easterly direction toward Philipsburg, Pennsylvania.
7. As Robert Greenawalt was approaching said intersection, the Defendant did, without properly observing traffic conditions on Route No. 322, entered onto Route No. 322 and in so doing, did drive to the left of the center of Route 322 and did occupy a

portion of traffic being then and there occupied by Robert Greenawalt, and did strike the automobile of the Plaintiff.

8. The Defendant was negligent in the following respects:

A. In failing to yield one-half of the main travelled portion of said Route No. 322;

B. In entering a thru highway without observing traffic conditions on said highway;

C. In driving in a careless and reckless manner.

D. In failing to take in to consideration the rights of other lawful users of the highway, and in particular, the rights of the said Robert Greenawalt.

9. As a result of Defendant's negligence in the operation of his mother vehicle, Plaintiff's motor vehicle was completely demolished.

10. Immediately prior to said accident, Plaintiff's motor vehicle had a value of \$150.00, and as a result of the said accident, Plaintiff's vehicle was a total loss with the exception of salvage value of \$20.00 leaving a net loss to the Plaintiff of \$130.00.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff brings this action against the Defendant in the liquidated amount of \$130.00 plus interest by reason of delay.
