COMPLAINT

AND NOW, comes the plaintiff, CATHY LYNN STEFFEY, by and through her counsel, NICHOLAS F. LORENZO, JR., ESQ., of LORENZO & GIANVITO, P.C., who files the following Complaint, of which the facts set forth hereinafter are a true and concise summary:

1. Plaintiff, CATHY LYNN STEFFEY, is an adult individual, who resides at R.D. #5, Box 484, Punxsutawney, Jefferson County, Pennsylvania, 15767.

2. Defendant, JOHN J. GLASNER, is an adult individual who resides at R.R. 3, Box 397, Greentown, Pike County, Pennsylvania, 18426.

3. At all times relevant to this Complaint, there existed within Bloom Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, a roadway known as State Route 219, which runs generally in a north-south direction.

4. At approximately 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, July 31, 1999, plaintiff, CATHY LYNN STEFFEY, was operating her vehicle, a 1996

Chevrolet Lumina, southbound on the aforescribed S.R. 219; at the same time, defendant, JOHN J. GLASNER, was traveling north on the same roadway in his 1990 Mazda Miata. As he was traveling downhill in a right curve near the intersection with S.R. 3011, Irishtown Road, Chestnut Grove, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, JOHN J. GLASNER allowed his vehicle to cross the centerline of the roadway directly into plaintiff's lane of travel. Despite Ms. Steffey's attempt to avoid a collision by moving onto the right berm, a collision did occur between both front driver sides, causing severe damage to both vehicles. Following the initial impact, the Steffey vehicle exited the road surface and came to rest against a utility pole, facing south. The Glasner vehicle re-crossed the northbound lane and came to rest on the east berm, facing east.

5. Defendant, JOHN J. GLASNER, was negligent and careless in the following respects:

- a) Operating his vehicle without keeping a proper lookout for other vehicles lawfully traveling upon the roadway;
- b) Failing to keep his vehicle under proper control by preventing it from crossing the centerline of the roadway and striking plaintiff's vehicle;
- c) Operating his motor vehicle in a careless and inattentive manner;
- d) Failing to operate his vehicle on the right side of the highway;
- e) Crossing the centerline of the highway and striking another vehicle;

f) Failing to drive at a safe speed that would not permit him to lose control and cross the centerline of the highway;

g) Failing to operate his vehicle so as to be able to come to a complete stop within the assured clear distance ahead;

h) Violating the statutes of the Commonwealth, specifically, Section 3309, "driving wrong way on roadway laned for travel".

6. Due to the stated negligence and carelessness of the defendant, the plaintiff, CATHY LYNN STEFFEY, despite being seatbelted, was thrown violently forward within the passenger compartment of her vehicle. After being trapped in her vehicle for a period of time, she was removed by emergency personnel and transported via ambulance to the Dubois Regional Medical Center in Dubois, Pennsylvania, where she received treatment for her injuries.

7. As a result of the carelessness and negligence of the defendant, plaintiff sustained personal injuries, requiring her to receive medical or therapeutic treatment. Plaintiff's personal injuries suffered as a result of defendant's conduct are as follows:

- a) loss of consciousness or post-impact confusion;
- b) neck pain;
- c) radiating pain from right shoulder to middle finger;
- d) severe bruises on left side, including her thigh, hip, and foot;
- e) multiple cuts on face, hands, both arms and left leg;
- f) emotional upset.

8. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the defendant, plaintiff has had her health, safety and vitality impaired, and she has sustained great pain, suffering, mental anguish, inconvenience and embarrassment.

9. As a result of the carelessness and negligence of the defendant, plaintiff has in the past, and will in the future, be required to expend sums of money for medical care, treatment and medications necessary for the care of her aforescribed injuries.

10. Plaintiff has in the past, and will in the future, be forced to endure pain, suffering, inconvenience, embarrassment and loss of the quality of her life, all as a direct result of the negligence and carelessness of the defendant.

11. At the time of the incident described herein, plaintiff was employed as a veterinarian's assistant, working approximately 35 hours a week, earning \$7.70/hour. At a result of the injuries sustained in the subject accident, Ms. Steffey was unable to work for a period of approximately two weeks, thereby sustaining a loss of income from this position, all as a direct result of the negligence and carelessness of the defendant.

12. As a result of the negligence and carelessness of the defendant, the future earning capacity of the plaintiff has been lessened, primarily due to the pain that she experiences in her neck and shoulders, and a limited range of motion when attempting to lift animals onto an examining table or into cages.

WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands judgment against defendant for a sum in excess of Twenty-Five Thousand and 00/100 (\$25,000.00) Dollars, or the maximum jurisdictional amount requiring arbitration.







NOW COMES, the defendant, John J. Glasner, by and through his attorney, Michael S. Marshall, Esquire, who files an Answer to plaintiff's Complaint, and avers as follows:

1. Admitted.

4. Admitted in part and denied in part. It is admitted that at the time and place described in the complaint, defendant's vehicle did cross the centerline of the highway and that plaintiff's vehicle and defendant's vehicle collided. It is denied that defendant "allowed" his vehicle to cross the centerline, to the extent that such allegation may imply that there was anything intentional or negligent about defendant's conduct. In addition, defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to

the truth of the averment that plaintiff attempted to avoid the collision by moving onto the berm, and the same is therefore denied.

5. The averment that defendant was negligent and careless is a conclusion of law, to which no responsive pleading is required. To the extent that an answer may be deemed to be necessary, it is denied that defendant was negligent or careless with respect to any of the allegations set forth in paragraph 5.(a) through (h). To the contrary, defendant was operating his vehicle in a careful and attentive manner, within the posted speed limits and at a speed which was safe and appropriate for the conditions then existing. Immediately prior to the collision, defendant encountered a sudden and severe rain storm which made it nearly impossible to see the roadway ahead and which caused his vehicle to "hydroplane", making it impossible for defendant to steer the vehicle as he attempted to negotiate the curve in the road. The collision was caused by such unexpected and unavoidable weather conditions, and not by the manner in which defendant was operating his vehicle.

6. Denied. For the reasons set forth above, it is denied that defendant was negligent or careless. With regard to the remaining averments of paragraph 6, defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to their truth.

7. Denied. For the reasons set forth above, it is denied that defendant was negligent or careless. With regard to the remaining averments of paragraph 7, defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to their truth.

8. Denied. For the reasons set forth above, it is denied that defendant was negligent or careless. With regard to the remaining averments of paragraph 8, defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to their truth.

9. Denied. For the reasons set forth above, it is denied that defendant was negligent or careless. With regard to the remaining averments of paragraph 9, defendant is without knowledge or information sufficient to form a belief as to their truth.


