To the Hon Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of Wexford County

The undersigned citizens of Briggs tps said
County, would respectfully present that on the
petition of Citizens of Bradford tps at Sep 2 1868
an order was granted and viewers appointed to
view and report on the propriety of changing
the line of Bradford tps, so as to change its into
Briggs tps for school purposes. That such view was
made and reported on favorably and on the
11th Oct 1868 Confirmed. We, Sir by this County
Against the absolute Confirmation of said report
your petition protest for the reason

1st That said change is asked simply to subvert
personal interests, and is altogether unnecessary

2^d That two families live in that portion of Bradford
now asked to be thrown into Briggs for school
purposes, and if they from distance or other causes
are deprived of the use of schools in the
tp in which they now live, the school laws
expressly provides for the schooling ^{of} such
by an arrangement between the Directors
of adjoining Districts, and no changing
of tps ^{lines} is necessary

3 That this change is not asked ^{for by} such a number of the citizens of Bradford interested therein as will justify the Council in making it, And the families included in it, can have no greater School advantages than they are now entitled to, without the erection of a new School House in their vicinity, which would be attended with an expense, unwarranted in this case, and be burdensome on the citizens of Bradford.

They therefore respectfully ask that such a change in the City limits for school purposes may not be made.
