

We the undersigned (Viewers appointed by the foregoing Order of Court to View the road therein described) Do Report, that after having first been duly sworn & Affirmed according to Law we did thereupon all proceed upon the ground and have Viewed laid out and do return for Public use the following road Beginning at the Public road near Hoyle's Bridge thence At $71\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 63 perches to a post. South 74 degrees East 15 perches thence South 51 degrees East 32 perches to a small Birch. thence S. 73° E. 70 perches to a Hemlock Stump. thence S. 52° E. $22\frac{1}{2}$ perches to small Pine. South 61° East 42 perches to a post. Then South 73° East 14 perches to a Hemlock. Then South $83\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 19 perches to a Post. Then South $88\frac{1}{2}$ degrees East 13 perches to a post. Then North 76° East 30 perches. Then South 84° East 34 perches to laid out road near the mouth of Hockenberry run a Plot or Draft of which we hereunto annex

ROAD VIEWERS.

CLEARFIELD COUNTY SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Clearfield, held at Clearfield in and for said county, on the 29 day of September, A. D. 1868, before the Judges of the said Court, upon the petition of sundry inhabitants of the township of Ferguson, in the said county, setting forth that they labor under great inconvenience for the want ^{a vacation} of a road or highway leading from Near the mouth of Hockenberry's Run to near Dr John P. Hoyts Mills

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. Whereupon, the Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

Thos. W. Moore, Joseph Moore and John D. Miller who, after being respectively sworn or affirmed to perform the duties of their appointment with impartiality and fidelity, are to view the ground proposed for said road; and if any two of them agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to ~~view~~ ^{vacate} lay out the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect for the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, in such manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report thereof, stating particularly whether they judge the same ^{un}necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which it may pass, to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law.
