PETITION

AND NOW, come the undersigned, and petition your Honorable Court pursuant to the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. §65407, to appoint Supervisors to the Township Board of Supervisors because of vacancies. The undersigned hereby affirm to your Honorable Court the following:

1. Each of the undersigned signature parties, being fifteen or more in number, are duly registered electors of Huston Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.
2. Huston Township is a Second Class Township and has a three person Board of Supervisors.
3. Presently, there are two vacancies that have not been filled in the Board of Supervisors, therefore, the Board cannot function.
4. The Second Class Township Code, particularly 53 P.S. §65407, mandates the following:

". . .If two or more vacancies in the office of supervisor occur on a three-member board or three or more vacancies on a five-member board, the court of common pleas shall fill the vacancies upon presentation of petition signed by not less than fifteen electors of the township. The successor so appointed shall hold the office until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election which occurs more than sixty days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be elected for the unexpired term."

5. The duly appointed Secretary of Huston Township has verified by signature on this Petition that the vacancies have occurred, and such vacancies are duly recorded on the official minutes of Huston Township.

6. Because of vacancies, the Township has advertised for parties interested in serving in the Supervisor capacity. A list of interested parties, who are electors residing in the Township for more than one year, is attached hereto.

7. The undersigned Petitioners and Secretary of Huston Township hereby request your Honorable Court to fill the vacancies upon presentation of this Petition.

The above factual matters contained in this Petition are affirmed by the Township Secretary.


