ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in Decatur Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern right-of-way line of State Highway Route No. 17122 leading from Philipsburg to West Decatur, said State Highway being the old Erie Turnpike; thence North Sixty-five degrees thirty minutes East ($N 65^{\circ} 30' E$) a distance of eight hundred fifty-three (853') feet to a point on the Western right-of-way line of State Highway Route No. 322 leading from Philipsburg to West Decatur; thence along the Western right-of-way line of said highway South forty-two degrees ten minutes East ($S 42^{\circ} 10' E$) a distance of one hundred eighty-eight and fifty hundredths (188.50') feet to a point on the Southern side of Beaver Run; thence along the Southern side of Beaver Run South fifty-four degrees no minutes West ($S 54^{\circ} 00' W$) a distance of seven hundred seventeen (717') feet to a point on line of other land of prior grantors; thence along other lands of prior grantors and of L. and H. Waring North forty-one degrees fifteen minutes West ($N 41^{\circ} 15' W$) a distance of one hundred sixty (160') feet to a point; thence by line of L. and H. Waring South sixty-five degrees thirty minutes West ($S 65^{\circ} 30' W$) a distance of one hundred twenty (120') feet to a point on the aforementioned Eastern right-of-way line of State Highway Route No. 17122, formerly old Erie Turnpike; thence along the said Eastern right-of-way line North forty-one degrees fifteen minutes West ($N 41^{\circ} 15' W$) a distance of one hundred sixty (160') feet to a point, the place of beginning.
