



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the Department of Public Welfare, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the plaintiff named in the above entitled judgment, for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar, lawful money of the United States, to it paid by the defendant above named, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do eshereby forever acquit, exonerate, discharge and release from the lien of the above entitled judgment, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in The Township of Decatur, County of Clearfield, and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake corner, said corner being on the Northern right-of-way line of State Highway Route No. 53 leading from Philipsburg to Osceola Mills and on the Eastern side of a 20 ft. alley; thence along said alley North fifty-two degrees eighteen minutes West (N 52° 18' W) a distance of one hundred sixty-one and forty hundredths (161.40') feet to a stake; thence by land of Putman and Greene, Inc. North forty-six degrees fifty-three minutes East (N 46° 53' E) a distance of two hundred thirty-two and no hundredths (232.00') feet to an iron post corner; thence by line of Putman and Greene, Inc. South thirty-six degrees thirty-eight minutes East (S 36° 38' E) a distance of two hundred twenty-seven and seventy-five hundredths (227.75') feet to the aforementioned right-of-way line of Highway Route No. 53; thence along said right-of-way line South sixty-seven degrees no minutes West (S 67° 00' W) a distance of one hundred ninety-one and ten hundredths (191.10') feet to the place of beginning. Containing 0.90 Acres and having thereon a two story frame dwelling and other buildings.

BEING the same premises as were sold and conveyed unto Charles E. Barnard and Jennie M. Barnard, his wife, by Deed of John C. Bainey, et ux, dated June 10, 1954 and recorded in the Office for the Recording of Deeds in and for Clearfield County, Pennsylvania in Deed Book Vol. 436, page 65. The said Charles E. Barnard having died November 9, 1965 thereby vesting complete title in the said Jennie M. Barnard. And it is further agreed that the plaintiff above named will not look to the said above mentioned and described premises or any part thereof, for payment of any part of the principal and interest of said above entitled judgment, now or hereafter to become due, or in any way disturb, molest, put to charge or damage, the present or any future owner or owners, occupier or occupiers of the said above mentioned and described premises, or any part or portion thereof, for or by reason of the said judgment, or any matter, cause or thing thence accruing or to arise: Provided, that nothing herein contained shall affect the said judgment or its legal validity, so far as respects all other lands and tenements of the said defendant situate in the County aforesaid, which are not herein expressly exonerated therefrom.


