
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APPEAL FROM SUSPENSION OF OPERATOR'S LICENSE

MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE SAID COURT:

AND NOW, comes Petitioner, through his attorney, Joseph L. Amendola, Esquire, who requests the following relief:

1. Petitioner is RANDY S. WILSON, who resides at Market Street, P.O. Box 155, Karthaus, Pennsylvania 16845.
2. Petitioner has been issued Pennsylvania Driver's License Number 23644723.
3. By letter dated November 12, 2001, Petitioner was advised that his driving privileges were being suspended for a period of one (1) year as a result of a violation of Section 1547 of the Vehicle Code: CHEMICAL TEST REFUSAL for a violation which occurred on October 17, 2001.
4. Petitioner believes the suspension is improper due to the fact that Petitioner does not believe that he refused to submit to a chemical test.
5. Petitioner received notification on Wednesday afternoon, November 26, 2003 that his hearing in this matter was scheduled to be heard by this Honorable

Court on Wednesday, December 10, 2003 at 9:00 a.m. at the Clearfield County Courthouse.

6. Petitioner has maintained from the time of his arrest on the charge of driving under the influence that his refusal to submit to a blood test in this matter was related to his medical condition and that he did not knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily refuse to submit to a blood test at Clearfield Hospital on October 18, 2001.

7. Petitioner has been examined by several medical and psychological experts since his arrest on October 18, 2001 beginning on October 21, 2001 and all have determined Petitioner suffered a concussion at the time of his accident on October 17, 2001, and, thereafter, suffered from post-concussion syndrome which prevented him from cooperating with police at Clearfield Hospital and making a knowing, intelligent and voluntary decision to refuse to submit to a blood test on October 18, 2001.

8. Because of the late notice of the hearing date in this matter, the experts whom Petitioner needs to testify on his behalf at his license suspension appeal hearing are unavailable on December 10, 2003.

9. Specifically, Petitioner contacted Dr. Mitchell Felder, a board certified medical expert in Neurology and Diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, whom Petitioner had previously retained as an expert witness in his case, at his first opportunity on Monday, December 1, 2003 following the four-day Thanksgiving Day holiday and was advised by Dr. Felder he is unavailable to appear as a witness until, at the earliest, late January or February of next year.

10. Other medical experts, who are involved in this matter, are also unavailable to appear as witnesses on Petitioner's behalf on December 10, 2003.

11. Petitioner cannot prevail at his hearing on his appeal from suspension of operator's license without the testimony of these medical experts, and most importantly, Dr. Felder.

12. Petitioner will be greatly and irreparably prejudiced if he cannot present these experts as witnesses at his hearing.

13. The Commonwealth will not be prejudiced by a continuance in this matter.


14. Petitioner is an employee of Verizon and requires his license to work at his occupation for Verizon.






